Speaking at a discussion to mark the 31st National Cooperatives Day here, he urged the officials and employees of the co-operative department to come forward with honesty, sincerity and mutual exchanges to achieve the goal.

Department of Co-operatives and Jatiya Samabaya (Co-operative) Union jointly organised the discussion at the BCIC auditorium here.

Stressing the need for reducing dependency on the government

for making the co-operative department self-reliant, he said the government control on any organisation increases due to increased dependency.

He said a new law would be enacted for the people who are involved in co-operative movements bringing amendments to the old one in the next parliament session.

Among other things, Bhuiyan said, the government undertook measures to turn the Co-operative Bank into a commercial bank and bring about a "milk revolution" within the next four years through Milk Vita, he added.
