

First round of 11th NID on Mar 30

The first and second round of 11th National Immunisation Day will be observed on March 30 and May 4 next year across the country. The decision was taken at a meeting of the National Steering Committee for vaccination with Health and Family Welfare Minister Dr Khondokar Mosharrar Hossain in the chair.

About two crore children under five years will be vaccinated to eradicate polio from the country on the National Vaccination Day. Each child will be administered a vitamin A capsule with two doses of polio vaccines in the first round. The minister said the enclaves of both Bangladesh and India will be brought under the vaccination programme. He also directed the officials to

take steps for vaccinating the children in the border areas and setting up permanent vaccination centres at the airports, said an official release. Among others Health Secretary Mohammad Fazlur Rahman, Additional Secretary Mohammad Lutfur Rahman Chowdhury, Director of Health Department and other officials were present in the meeting.
