In addition to a monthly amount of Tk 2,000, each recipient will get a lump sum amount of Tk 5,000 annually for purchase of books and other essentials.

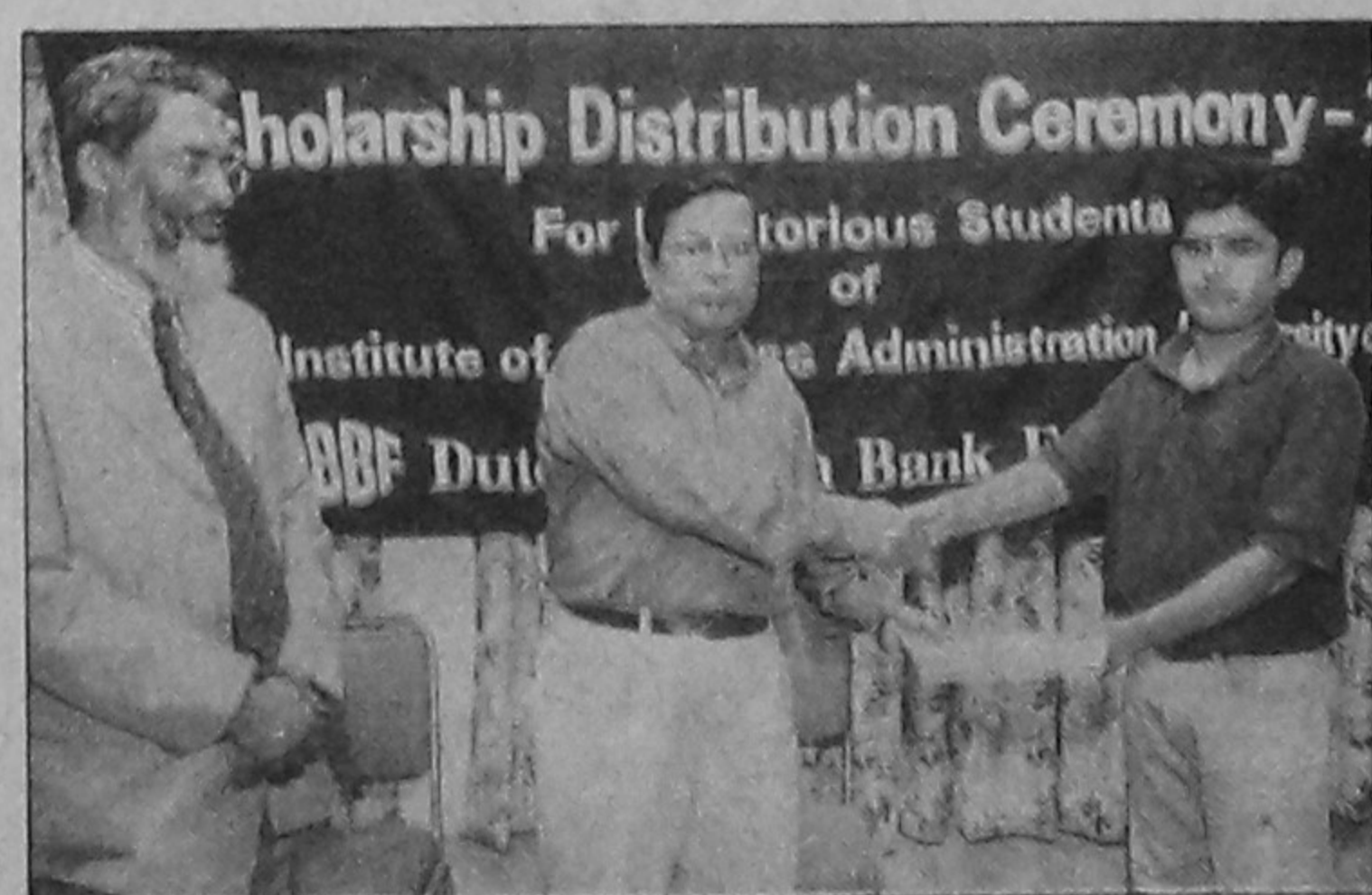
