

# Rly asked to raise revenue

**BSS, Dhaka**  
 Communications Minister Nazmul Huda yesterday directed Bangladesh Railway (BR) to raise its internal revenue by making highest commercial use of its unutilised lands in different parts of the country.  
 The directives came at a meeting of Bangladesh Railway Authority (BRA) held at the Rail Bhaban with Nazmul Huda in the chair.  
 The minister said every sub-sector of the BR should be made income-generating for raising its internal income.  
 The meeting discussed in detail realisation of contractual fund from private companies running the rail service on private management, recovery of railway lands from illegal occupation and strengthening the drive for eviction of encroachment and illegal structures from the lands.  
 The setting up of CNG gas sta-

tion on railway lands and steps taken earlier for raising the standard of passenger service also figured at the meeting.

Huda said if the highest commercial use of the untapped lands of Bangladesh Railway could be made, the income of the railway could be increased.

Besides, a huge amount of money could be supplied to the development budget of the country and dependence on foreign aid for development efforts could be reduced, he added.

State Minister for Communications Salahuddin Ahmed, Communications Secretary Syed Rezaul Hayat, Bangladesh Railway Director General M Ataur Rahman, Planning Commission Member Mirza Tasadduk Hossain Beg, FBCCI President Yusuf Abdullah Haroon, BGMEA President Kutubuddin Ahmed and BRA members were present at the meeting.

# Body to finalise transfer of land for Zia Smriti Complex

 A four-member secretarial committee has been formed to finalise transfer of land and other formalities for constructing Shaheed Zia Smriti Complex at Kalurghat in Chittagong.  
 The committee comprises secretaries of the ministries of land, housing and works, information and liberation war affairs.  
 The committee was formed at the second meeting of the ministerial committee on construction of the complex here yesterday with its chairman and State Minister for Liberation War Affairs Redwan Ahmed in the chair.  
 Committee members, Information Minister Tariqul Islam, Shipping Minister Lt Col (ret'd) Akbar Hossain, Foreign Minister M Morshed Khan, State Minister for Civil Aviation and Tourism Mir Mohammad Nasiruddin and State Minister for IGRD and Cooperatives Ziaul Huq Zia attended the meeting.  
 The meeting also set up a seven-member jury board with a senior architect as its head to finalise the design of the complex, which will be built with an aim to project the history of proclamation of the country's independ-

ence to the posterity.

"The earmarked land for the project is owned by the ministry of information, and the secretarial committee will formalise the transfer of land to the ministry of liberation war affairs and take necessary housing arrangements for residents of the land," Redwan said.

He said the design will be selected from an open bid and approved by the jury board. The spot from where Shaheed Zia announced country's independence, would be bloomed up with an abstract sculpture, he added.

A 71-feet high memorial com-

memorating the proclamation of independence along with a bust sculpture of Ziaur Rahman will be built either at the main entrance or in the core of the complex, he said.

He said the circumstances of the 11 sectors of the Liberation War will be reflected in the memorial and the equipment, used in the War, will be displayed.  
 Besides, a multi-purpose auditorium and planetarium will also be built at the complex, he said, adding that the complex will be decorated and featured with fountain, reservoir, museum and library on liberation affairs to attract the people, particularly the children.

The ministerial committee was formed on July 9 to construct the complex and the first meeting of the committee was held on July 23.
