Capturing dreams through the lens

Pierre Claquin's photo exhibition at Alliance Francaise: Part of Chhobi Mela-11

ALKING about why he had chosen the rural circus of Bangladesh for his recent exhibit at Alliance Française. Dr. Pierre Claquin said that initially it was because of his work, the inoculation of children, that brought him in touch with the subject of circus for the dissemination his message. When Dr Claquin asked around Bangladesh, he found that the situation was different from that of fifteen years ago. He first came to Bangladesh in 1972 -1973 as a fully qualified medical officer and then he was in charge of one 'thana' for the Bangladesh government in Shairkandi, Bogra. He came back later for the smallpox eradication programme for ICDDRB, to work for Matlab. Later he took his project to Sirajganj. Dr Claquin's focus is to improve the access of people to health care and has worked before in Central Africa. He is basically an epidemiologist who works to eradicate cholera, small pox and guinea worm and now for the last four years, poliomyelitis.

Dr Claquin has held photo exhibits before in Bangladesh in 2000 with 45 portraits of various Bangladeshi people; this was followed by the Berlin Wall exhibit at the Goethe Institut on the eastern part of the Berlin Wall, at a time when the Berlin Wall was being destroyed. Various unknown artists had painted the eastern side of the wall and this was important for the deep political criticism, the ecological concern, and the touching concern for where the world should in fact be. Forty-five pictures had been presented there and the difficult part was to provide the suitable captions to make the young local people comprehend what had happened long time ago as the paintings appeared somewhat abstract without the necessary historical background. Dr Claquin's attention had been



earlier drawn to the Shariakandi scenario as a major part of it has been eaten up by river erosion. I incidentally, he had taken pictures of this phenomenon when he had accompanied Tanvir Mukammal, for the latter's film on the Jomuna River, and had lived with 14 other people in a boat.

Speaking about how this present exhibition had become a part of the current "Chhobi Mela-11", Dr Claquin said that Dr Shahidul Alam of "Drik" had invited him to participate in it. At first he was a little reluctant as there was already an



exhibition on the circus by an Indian photographer in "Chhobi Mela 1". Dr Shahidul Alam was the one who had selected 33 of his photographs for the occasion at La Galerie, A F. Asked to elaborate on the "Chhobi Mela" Dr Claquin said that the exhibit was being held in 15 different places in Dhaka and comprised of the works of both local and foreign photographers; that it was being held to give the public of a Dhaka an opportunity to see many different photographic exhibitions. This is free and all clustered in the city, giving an international focus on south Asia. It is an incredible initiative, he said, and a lot of work to organize s.

Dwelling on why he had chosen

black and white and why he had

not gone in for colour, whether it was to add drama and if it was more of a challenge, Dr Claquin said. "Yes, but there is a debate on whether black and white is more dramatic or not, as people sometimes feel that black and white sometimes introduces more drama, more romantic view, while others say that it is little bit superficial, easy, and that it is, if one may take a more prestigious example. Sebastao Salagado, is being presented in "Chhobi Mela-1', who has been criticized for making developments and there were the difficulties at times, when he deals with situations like war etc. making it too aesthetic and pleasing. For me that was not the idea. Earlier I had mostly used colour but here I used black and white because I felt that it would help focus on the subject and there would be less distracting elements. Circus can have a lot of colours so that I felt that black and white would help bring the eyes of the people, looking at the pictures, to be more focused on the subject and concentrate more on what really was happening at the scene. Also, there is another element in black and white as one can use 400 ASA



(which means the sensitivity of the film) and it means that you don't have to use a flash even when you have poor lights and have to condition it with the darkness around. It might be more difficult if you do it in colours. Primarily the choice of the black and white was to help focus on the subject and it was also the fact that it might be a little bit easier to take the photos.'

Discussing the most difficult shots that he had taken, Dr Claquin said, "Any time there was fast action, weather it was the trapeze.

where we had people falling or cycling over the rope, where there was a net below, people doing conjuring tricks, sawing the blades on the people etc., which were a little bit technically difficult technically that is. My main concern was how to show the interaction between the singer, dancer, other performers and the public. "Again I had to find out how to

do it in a way that would present the reality, and at the same time, does not leave any misunder-

dancers and singers generally leave some misconceptions. People feel that they are a bit too sensuous or that they are flirting with the public etc. This is not true as there is a tremendous pressure on the circus to entertain the people, and one is sorry about this misunderstanding. The circus people feel discontented that the quality of the act is getting somewhat 'cheap' and that they do not get the respect that they deserve. However, at the same time, if the circus of three hours does not show an hour of dancing, some people may become very riotous and restless and want a return of their tickets. They come to the circus, in fact, to see young dancing girls as a part of the show. My difficulty was how to show this in a way that reflects the reality of life in the circus without opening the door to any criticism. "

Asked how the viewers would take such an exhibition during Ramzan, as one might misconstrue this at the present juncture, Dr Claquin said, "The circus does not work during the Ramzan and the authority did not chose the date of the 'Chhobi Mela-11' much before. In this exhibition, the public may, in fact, raise their eyebrows somewhat. Yet, anyone who has watched the circus will find animals like the elephant; jokers, the singer, the dancer, the trapeze performers a pale rendition of what actually happens in a circus. I don't think that there is anything in my exhibition that would offend the sensibility of the viewers. We from overseas are attuned to the sensibilities of the viewers in Bangladesh. We felt that it would interest anybody and attract a lot of viewers. The dancing girls have been treated in a respectful way. I feel that it is for the public to decide; I think that the exhibit is perfectly in line with what one may have felt about the circus performance in the Bangladesh rural areas.'

Asked if had faced any difficulties when he had gone about his work for his exhibition Dr. Claquin said," As a matter of fact, no. I was absolutely surprised and it is clear to any viewer that it has taken a lot of time and preparation to find out who was doing what in the circus, the subject of the exhibit i.e. I and my colleagues and friends, who accompanied me, were accepted by the owner, managers and performers of the circus with open arms. What I did was the minimum that I could do, although I took thousands of pictures out of there has been a selection of 33of them. which had been selected by Dr Shahidul Alam of 'Drik'. I had given a copy of each picture to the artistes so that everyone has a portrait of his act with lamination (so that the pictures would last longer). My dream is to give each of the artistes a copy of the book, which is going to be published in future. I hope to sign up for this with UPL. The most interesting part of the book for me is the interview with hundreds of artistes, the mangers and the owner of the circus. We have them on tape, beginning with a questionnaire along with the answers. I have so far 50 to 60 cassettes to this end portraying the life in the circus. I hope I shall be able to convey and express the right image of circus life in the book. The aim of the book is to give a voice to the people and provide them an opportunity for the Bangladeshi public to understand what circus people have to say for themselves: how they perceive the public and how they see their own lives as they suffer so much to make a living. The book will be to introduce all the circuses in Bangladesh, with accompanying commentaries with the circus people expressing themselves.'
