**Graft case against Engr Mosharraf Order on charge-framing on November 28**

The Special Court for Dhaka Division yesterday fixed November 28 for order on charge-framing against former housing and public works minister Engineer Mosharraf Hossain and former Awami League lawmaker Master Mojibur Rahman in connection with a graft case.

Judge Mohammad Azizul Haque passed the order after completion of hearing on the charges.

In the case filed with Motijheel thana, it has been alleged that Mosharraf, while in his office, directed the chairman of Rajuk to

allot five kathas of land to Mojibur Rahman at Uttara instead of Gulshan as he (Mojibur) had no plot within the approved area of Rajuk in the city.

Mohammad Jalal Uddin, an Inspector of the Bureau of the Anti-Corruption (BAC) filed the case against the accused on April 1, this year.

The investigation officer of the case submitted a charge sheet against the two on June 24 showing 10 people as prosecution witnesses.

Mosharraf Hossain and Mojibur Rahman, now on bail, were present in the court, during the hearing.

Special Public Prosecutor (PP) appeared for the state while Advocate Syed Rezaur Rahman for the accused.
