

HC grants bail to Janakantha reporter

The High Court yesterday granted anticipatory bail to journalist Tofail Ahmed of daily Janakantha and issued a rule asking the government to show cause why the petitioner should not be enlarged on permanent bail in connection with the case relating to two foreign journalists of the British Channel-4 who came to Bangladesh concealing their identity.

A division bench comprising Justice Mohammad Abdur Rashid and Justice Siddiqur Rahman Miah passed the order upon a petition moved before the court. It was reported that the ar-

rested foreign journalists had meetings with Tofail Ahmed, the Cox's Bazar reporter of daily Janakantha. A criminal case was lodged

with Motijheel thana on November 25 on alleged anti-state activities of the two foreign journalists and their local associates.

Advocate Subrata Chowdhury moved the petition on behalf of Tofail Ahmed while deputy attorney general Sheikh Abdul Awal stood for the state.
