## HC rule on detention of Mukul Bose, Momtaz Mehedi

The High Court vesterday issued a rule asking the government to show cause in a week why the detention of Mukul Bose and Mamataz Uddin Mehedi should not be declared illegal.

A division bench comprising Justice Mohammad Hamidul Haque and Justice Salma Masud Chowdhury passed the order.

Awami League leader Mukul Bose was arrested on December 8 and detained for 30 days on December 12.

Advocate Mamataz Uddin Mehedi, former general secretary of Dhaka District Bar Association, was arrested on December 9 and detained for 30 days on December 10 under the Special Powers Act, raise tuition and other fees.






