

AYBI Siddiqi said rapid migration and urbanisation are creating health and environmental degradation in cities, where the urban poor have less access to primary healthcare facilities compared to their rural counterpart.

Sunceta Mukherjee said the country's urban population is now growing at 6 per cent annually, which is three times the national average of 2 per cent.

At present, 25 per cent Bangladeshis are living in urban areas against a mere 5 per cent 30 years ago. By the year 2010, it is projected that 55 million people would be living in cities, the UN-FPA official said.

She said 50 per cent of the slum inhabitants are poor while 30 per cent classifiable hardcore poor with little or no access to basic facilities such as piped water,
