




The Hudsucker Proxy Star Movies, December 29 at 9.15 p.m.

The conferences were organized through the efforts of the Bangladesh Environment and Flood Committee in America (BEFCA), a group of Bangladeshi Americans, and the Institute of Flood Control and Drainage Research of the Bangladesh University of Engineering and

A range of vulnerabilities, and an unfulfiled potential for development are the main features of the coastal belt in the southeastern part of Bangladesh. On a dayto-day basis the people living on the coastal belt has to address vulnerabilities as diverse in nature as drainage congestion and the salinity of the soil constraining agricultural yields, cyclones and storms that pose risks to lives and property. Additionally, a heterogeneous social environment with undue influence of well positioned land grabbers can make life and living difficult.
