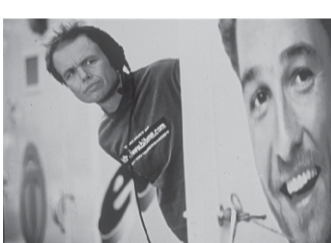
Conspiracy

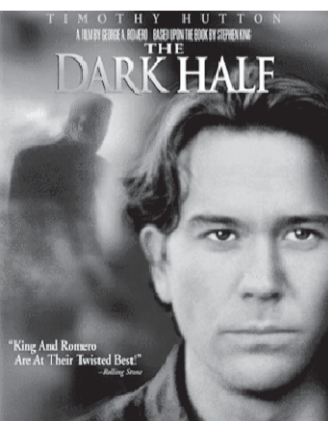
Babe: Pig In The City

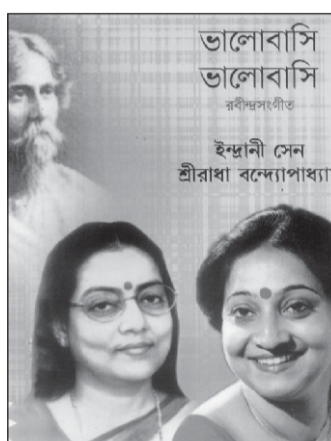


Lucky Numbers

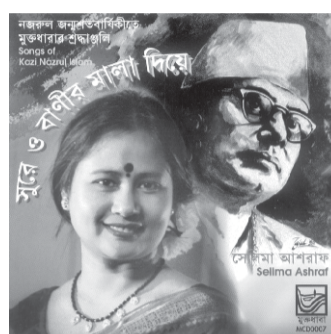


The Killer Next Door

Things go terribly wrong when a troubled young man who works in a mental institution sets out to seduce a patient who has accidentally escaped.

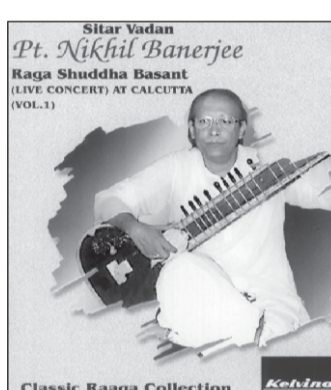

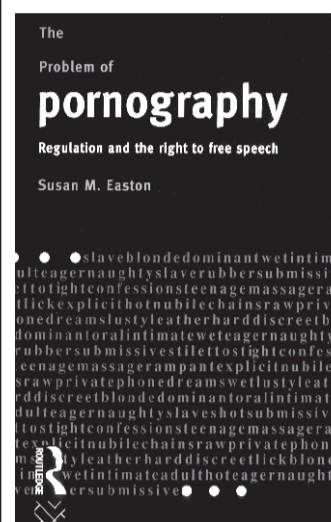
Megh O Roudro

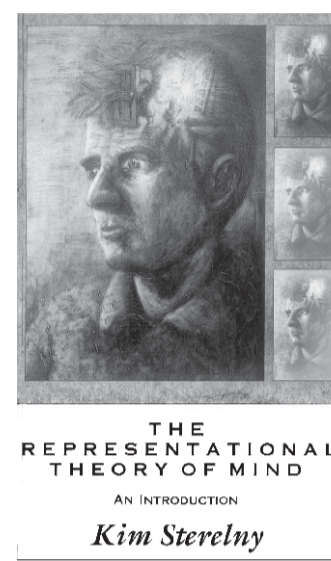
Bhoomi Isspecial
