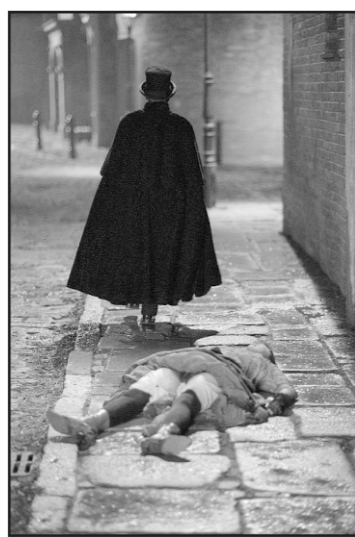


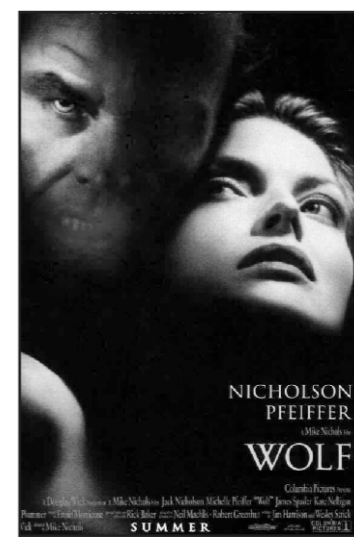

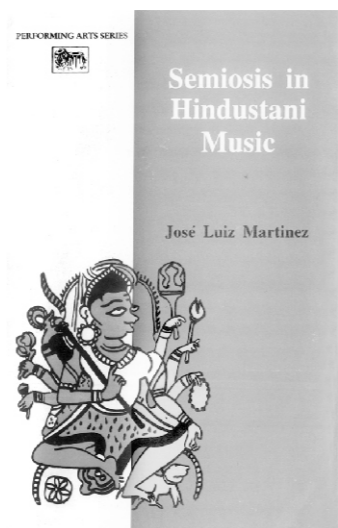


Brotherhood of the Wolf

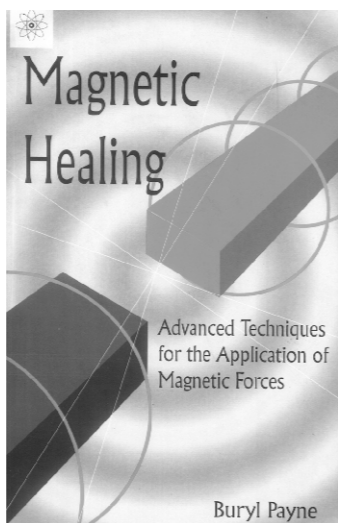


Unbreakable

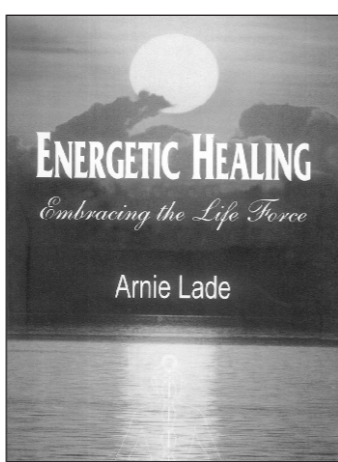

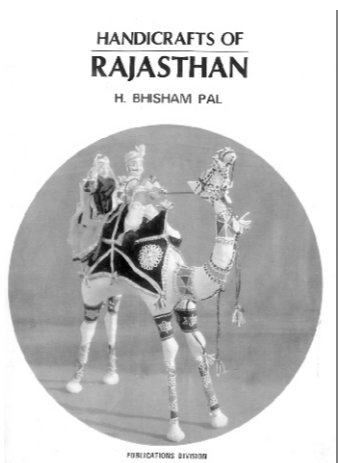
Semiosis in Hindustani Music
