# ADMISSION CRITERIA

☐ Students with successful 12 years' of schooling can apply for admission. ['O' Level with at least 5 subjects with a minimum of 4 points (based on the calculation of A=4, B=3, C=2 and D=1); or North American High School Diploma, International Baccalaureate, or equivalent] 

Students who have taken HSC and A-level exams but results are yet to be published can apply provisionally and take the Admission Test. 

All applicants must pass the Admission Test to be eligible for admission. 

No other considerations are acceptable for admission. 

B.A., B.Com., B.Sc. pass certificate holders and Diploma Engineers in Computer Science may appear in separate Admission Tests for determination of allowable credits in 4-year Degree Programs. There will be a separate evening classes for them.

# Application Forms

Application Forms to be available from August 7, 2003 from Presidency University Campus (House # 11/A, Road # 92, Gulshan-2, Dhaka-1212).

A fee of Tk.200/- (non-refundable) only for processing the application is payable. For overseas applicants, the fee shall be US\$4/- only. In order to receive application forms by mail, please write to the Admission Office along with a bank draft or pay order for Tk.200/- in favor of Presidency University, along with a self- addressed stamped envelope.

#### **Application Package** The completed application package must be submitted to the Admission Office by August 21, 2003. An application must include the following documents:

**Admission Test** 

i. application form duly filled- in ii. two passport-size photograph iii. legible copies of SSC/ 'O'-Level and HSC/ 'A'-Level or Equivalent Examination certificates and mark sheets/transcripts

Admission Test in Mathematics, English and Analytical Ability will be held on August 24, 2003. Applicants must be seated by 8:45 AM and the test will begin at 9:00 AM. Applicants seeking admission to major in English (Literature and Language) will have a separate question paper with more emphasis on English language skills.

- ☐ The decision for admission shall be taken by the Admission Committee based on the candidate's academic ability and result/score in the admission test.
- The Admission Committee's decision shall be final.
- Selected applicants must complete admission formalities by September 10, 2003.
- Admission test is waived for applicants with a minimum score of 1200 in SAT and 550 in TOEFL.
- Candidates studying at other recognized universities may seek admission, but the decision on their credit transfer will be taken by the Admission Committee.

Admission Tests for admission in Engineering Programs will be held in the first week of September 2003. Exact date to be announced.
