### Rajshahi lawyers boycott courts

Lawyers of Rajshahi Bar Association (RBA) yesterday observed a daylong strike and staged a sit-in programme to protest what they said the government's adverse attitude towards the

All the lawyers of the bar abstained from attending the courts and took part in the sit-in programme in front of the district judge's court.

They also took out a procession and held a rally on the court pre-

Later addressing a press conference, the lawyers demanded immediate withdrawal of compulsory submission of income tax return, imposition of VAT on lawyers and provision of tradelicense for them.

They also demanded refixation of taxable income limit from Tk 90,000 to Tk 200,000, and the minimum tax limit at Tk 1,200 in place of Tk 3,600.

RBA President Advocate Ekramur Rasul said the government has unwisely taxed lawyers who are engaged in serving the poor people.

RBA General Secretary Advocate Mohammad Yahia read out a written statement at the press conference.
