Huge contraband drugs seized in city

BSS, Dhaka

Directorate of Drug Administration (DDA) in a sudden drive yesterday seized huge contraband drugs from two medicine shops in city.

Led by Assistant Director Dr M A Hakim the team in cooperation with the Criminal Investigation Department (CID), conducted the raid on some medicine shops in front of Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) after midday.

They seized 15 types of contrabands, including anti-cancer and anti-psychiatric medicines from Day Night Pharmacy and Islam Pharmacy. Talking to BSS, some pharmaceutical companies welcomed the drive, saying it will help ensure supply of safe medicines to the people.

They said if such drives are continued, awareness will be created among the people and medicine traders while smugglers will be discouraged.

JU hall officials on strike over JCD action

Administrative activities at Shahid Salam Barkat (SSB) hall in Jahangirnagar University (JU) collapsed as the hall authorities went into work abstention since Sunday night.

Hall officials started the programme following the confinement of the provost and house tutors of the SSB hall for three hours by the Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) leaders and activists.

As the office services stopped, the residents could not obtain hall clearance needed to sit for examinations.

The university authorities will not allocate seats to the freshers of

2002-03 academic session in the SSB hall as the hall authorities continue with their programme and the students are to face acute accommodation crisis.

Classes of 2002-03 academic session will start from Thursday.

The authorities are yet to take any decision regarding punishment to those involved in the Sunday night incident.

Jahangirnagar University Teachers Association meets today (Wednesday) to decide their plan of action if the guilty are not given exemplary punishment.

The JCD leaders cautioned against punishment to any of its activist. They also demanded immediate withdrawal of the expulsion

order against its activists, removal of the SSB hall provost and reshuffle in the hall committee.

"We will not allow entry of the hall authorities until our demand is met," said Parvez Mallik, JU unit president of the JCD.

When contacted over telephone, vice chancellor and pro-vice chancellor of the JU were not available for comment.

The JCD leaders and activists confined the provost and eight house tutors of the hall for three hours Sunday night as the authorities expelled three of its activists last Friday for beating up the manager and caterer of the hall canteen for non-payment of canteen bills.

ETV case verdict Aug 20
