Coalition wins by-polls

Khadija Amin declared winner; AL alleges intimidation

The four-party alliance candidate, Khadija Amin, was declared winner of Netrakona-3 by-polls yesterday as she took the lead with 95,251 votes in the 124 centres over her rival candidate with 69,966.

The main opposition party Awami League candidate, Jubed Ali, fell behind by 25,285 votes in the

second position of the seven-candidate by-polls yesterday, said the Election Commission in a late night press release.

Syed Abu Zafar Sabat of Krishak Sramik Janata League bagged 3,424 votes, followed by Abdul Wahab, an independent, with 890 votes. Ali Osman Khan from the Jatiya Party (Ershad) polled 869 votes; Mohammad Sadek from Krishak

Israel missiles Gaza, Hamas cancels truce 3 including top militant leader dead

A senior leader of the Palestinian militant group Hamas was killed in an air strike in Gaza City Thursday as Israel exacted revenge for a massive suicide bomb, hammering the final nail into the coffin of a floundering truce.

Ismail Abu Shanab, often described as the group's third-in-command, died when an F-16 plane targeted his car in an attack which claimed the lives of at least two other people, Hamas officials and witnesses said.

Hamas promptly announced that it was calling off its three-month

ceasefire announced on June 29 which had been effectively shattered by the Jerusalem attack.

"The assassination of Abu Shanab is also the assassination of the ceasefire," senior Hamas official Ismail Haniyeh told AFP.

Life stops briefly in Ctg to protest crime spate

Life in the port city stopped for 10 minutes yesterday noon as the city dwellers, particularly businessmen and professionals, observed a token strike to protest the slide in the law and order.

The strike aimed to press for immediate rescue of abducted magnate and BNP leader Jamal Uddin Ahmed Chowdhury and arrest of the killers of another magnate, Reazur Rahman Zakir.


Chittagong Nagarik Forum (CNF), a citizen's body, enforced the token strike with the support of

Chittagong Chamber of Commerce and Industry (CCCI) and other business organisations.

Public resentment has mounted in the port city as Jamal Uddin is yet to be rescued, 28 days after his abduction on July 24, and the probe into the August 11 abduction and murder of Zakir has made no headway.

The token strike began with the blowing of sirens exactly at noon and people came out on the streets. Business establishments downed their shutters and all modes of transport screeched to a halt for 10 minutes.

'Chemical Ali' caught

Baghdad blast kills Marine, hurts 2

Ali Hassan al-Majid, a feared cousin of Saddam Hussein nicknamed 'Chemical Ali' for his use of poison gas in attacks, has been captured by US forces in Iraq, the US military says.

"We do have him and he was captured alive," US Central Command spokesman Lt. Ryan Fitzgerald told Reuters.

Fitzgerald said no details were available on the arrest, where it took place, or whether Majid was injured.

Majid was No. 5 on a U.S. list of the 55 most-wanted Iraqis and the "king of spades" in a U.S. Army deck


