They said she was an outspoken politician and renowned social worker with human qualities.

Presided over by Prof Anisuzzaman, the meeting was participated by eminent citizens including political leaders, social workers, academics, and relatives of the deceased.  
Nurjahan Murshid was a pioneer in taking the society forward, said Sardar Fazul Karim.  
Advocate Sultana Kamal said she struggled throughout her life to uphold human and social values.  
Nurjahan Murshid played a pioneering role in bringing about women's progress, said Rashed Khan Menon.  
Her political contribution was an integral part of our history, said Dr Kamal Hossain adding that she was a light-bearer through various bleak episodes of our national history.  
Ayesha Khanam said we are indebted to Nurjahan Murshid for her immense contribution to the society.  
Advocate Subrata Chowdhury said her death should have been condoled nationally for her contribution to the war of liberation.

**BCL, JCD stage protests at DU**

Presided over by the JCD President Shahabuddin Lattu, the rally was addressed by the JCD General Secretary Azizul Bari Helal, Sultan Salahuddin Tuku, Selimuzzaman Selim and Amirul Islam Khan Alim.  
The Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) yesterday took out a procession and held a rally on the Dhaka University campus protesting the attack that left at least 50 pro-AL lawyers injured.  
The BCL, student wing of Awami League (AL), also protested the killing of AL leader in Khulna.  
BCL leaders said the ruling BNP-Jamaat government has been killing the oppositions in a planned way since they came to power.  
They vowed to resist the torture and killing by the ruling party men.  
Presided over by BCL President Liakat Shikder, the rally was addressed by BCL General Secretary Nazrul Islam Babu, Balaram Podder, Khan Moinul Islam Mostak, Zakir Hossain Maruf, Delwar Hossain, and Hemet Uddin Khan Himu.  
The Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) also brought out a procession and held a rally on the campus protesting the pro-AL lawyers' movement.  
Protesting the attack on Jubo Dal procession, the JCD, student wing of the ruling BNP, alleged that the pro-AL lawyers hurled bombs on the Jubo Dal procession.  
The JCD leaders said the opposition Awami League including its lawyers was trying to prevent establishing good governance in the country through criminal activities.
