Moni Singh's anniversary of death today

The 13th death anniversary of communist leader Comrade Moni Singh will be observed today with due respect.

Different political and cultural organisations including Communist Party of Bangladesh, Trade Union, Udichi Shilpi Goshthi, Khethmozur Samity, Krishak Samity, Chatra Union and Jubo Union have taken programmes to observe the day.
