Price: Tk 550.00 Shortly after the creation of Pakistan, the question of what would be the state lan-

guage became a burning issue. Banglaspeakers formed the single largest ethnic and linguistic majority. Nevertheless, the founder of Pakistan, MA Jinnah, declared that "Urdu and Urdu alone shall be the state language of Pakistan." The Bengali struggle for the rightful recognition of Bangla gained momentum. On 21st February 1952, police fired on a procession in Dhaka demanding recognition of Bangla as one of the state languages of Pakistan. In the firing Rafiq, Barkat, Jabbar, and Salam were killed along with others, leading to a spontaneous outpouring of grief and anger.




