He and his four dancers seem swift movers: dressed in black costume generated an array of breathtaking motions and gasps of wild energy. The dense black environment along with the greyish ash mat-platform made a reflection of a shadowy appearance of the set design to a frame where the spot light effects were prominent. The light effects apparently focused a completely new dimension of gestures--slashing arm movements across their bodies and the acrobatic twists articulated a mist of illusion emerging from every sequence.


