JU admission tests uncertain

The admission tests for first year honours courses in Jahangirnagar University (JU) under 2003-04 academic session have become uncertain.

Two deans yesterday informed the vice-chancellor in writing that it would not be possible for different faculties and departments to complete all preparations for the tests by March 17.

Dean of social science faculty Prof Sheikh Md Monjurul Huq and Dean of arts faculty Prof Afsar Ahmad urged the VC to reschedule the examinations again.

Prof. Afsar Ahmad also called on the authorities concerned at the central admission committee meeting on March 4 to give more time to hold the tests.

The authorities announced a new date for the tests from March 17 to 25. Earlier, the committee decided to hold the examinations from March 13 to 23, sources said.

A teacher, preferring anonymity,

said that most of the teachers are not willing to work under the present vice- chancellor. He said the stand-off may con-

tinue until a new VC is appointed from a three-member VC panel elected on February 19.
