Book launching

Chalachitravidhya: New book on film study by Anupam Hayat

T has been 48 years since the public release of Mukh O Mukhosh, the first ever feature film made in Bangladesh (then East Pakistan). And during this nearly half-acentury, our film industry has made its own history. But unfortunately film has always been a neglected sector, having no institutional foundation. There aren't many institutions that offer higher studies in film, and there is an immense shortage of qualified books and scholars in this sphere.

However, another title has recently been added to the existing scanty number of books on films. Reputed writer in this field Anupam Hayat has brought out a book, Chalachitravidhya (Film Studies), on fundamental aspects of film and film-related issues like film appreciation. Bangladesh Film Studies Centre (BFSC) organised the publication ceremony of the book on April 10 at Stamford University auditorium. Chairman of BFSC Rafiguzzaman, Chairman of the Department of Film and Media M Abdus Samad, filmmaker Chashi Nazrul Islam, actors Ashrafuddin Ahmed Ujjal and Kabori Sarwar, Dean of Arts faculty, Jahangirnagar University, Dr Afsar Ahmed, professor of Mass Communication and Journalism department. Dhaka University. Dr Golam Rahman, poet-journalist Sajjad Kadir and Zakiul Haque of Bangla Academy attended the programme.

country's film journalism. He has authored several books on film including Bangladesher Chalachitrer Itihash (History of Bangladesh Film), Shekaley Bangladesher Koyekjon Chalachitra Kormi (Some Film Activists of the Past), and a biography of one of the country's pioneer filmmakers Fateh Lohani.

Among the institutions that offer studies on film is BFSC where Anupam Hayat works as the chief course coordinator. He also teaches a few courses there. And from his experience at BFSC he realised that a book containing very fundamental issues of film is essential for the students. 'From this realisation I undertook the initiative of writing Chalachitravidhya,' he said at the ceremony.

The book of about 150 pages contain eight

chapters covering general ideas of cinema, a brief history of film in the world and its evolution, different elements and tactics of filmmaking, marketing of films, censorship laws, film appreciation, film related organisation and impact of films on the society. The chapter on the history of invention and evolution of film includes a substantial narration of its journey especially in the subcontinent. Discussions on various movements in the world film activities, such as Avant Garde, Expressionism, Realism, Cinema Verite, will give the reader a clear





ONATUNI, an offbeat audio production house, promotes authenticity of music and tries hard to encourage talented artistes rather than just focus purely on the profit motive. With limited organisational structure and effort, it always assists the prominent as well as upcoming artistes. Although its journey began with children's songs, it has earned credentials in the other arenas of music as well. Tonatuni has recently released three albums--Hey Nirupama, Ami Patheri Baul and Bhorer Doyel. The launching ceremony of the albums took place recently at Hotel Purbani.

Hey Nirupama is a Rabindra Sangeet album presenting a blend of songs and poems, inaugurated earlier by artist Mostofa Munwar. The album contains duets as well as solos by popular Rabindra Sangeet artistes Papiya Sarwar, Kaderi Kibria and Mita Haq, and recitation by Mujibur Rahman Dilu. Shedin dujone dulechinu bone, Badhu michhe raag korona, Mone robe kina robe are some of the splendid tunes of the cassette.

Bhorer Doyel is an album of modern Bangla songs performed by Sabina Yasmeen, Haimanti Shukla, Subeer Nandi. Shakila Zafar and MA Khalegue. There are also old Bangla tunes like Chokher jole gora, Harano diner majhe, Pagol mon and others by Late Alamgir Kabir and Syed Abdul Hadi. Ami Patheri Baul is a folk album

by Arif Dewan and contains a good number of songs like O majhire ghate bhirao, Dukkher shari gaiya ami and others.

Papyia Sarwar, Mita Haq, Arif Dewan, Shakila Zafar and the music director of the three albums Sujeyo Shyam were present at the programme. Mujibur Rahman Dilu of Tonatuni conducted the whole

She, however, praised Tonatuni for always helping to conserve the authenticity of music, and said, 'It is encouraging that Tonatuni will come forward to initiate the royalty custom.

In her speech Mita said: 'We are hopeful that Tonatuni will promote music in its pure form among the next generation.' She also highlighted the necessity of royalty tradition, as it is a common custom everywhere in the world. Shakila Zafar, Sujeyo Shyam and Arif Dewan also raised the same question and were proud to be in touch with the production house.

After the discussion session, songs were played from the three albums. Singer Kiran Chandra Ray, dancer Tamanna Rahman and others were also present on the occassion.

With Tonatuni at the helm, the talented artists of this country can hope for better times ahead.
