## University student commits suicide

A student of Ahsanullah Science and Technology University (ASTU) allegedly committed suicide at his home at North Ibrahimpur in the city's Kafrul area on Sunday.

Mashikur Rahman Akand, 22, was found hanging with a rope from the ceiling of his room in the evening when the family members entered

the room cutting open the window grills as the door was locked from inside.

"Mashik had his lunch at around 2:00pm with us and went to his room for study to prepare for his examinations scheduled to begin on April 17," his brother Zakiul Alam said in the first information report he filed with Kafrul Police Station.

But hearing no sound from his room for hours, worried family members broke open the window only to find him hanging.

Police sent the body to Dhaka Medical College Hospital for autopsy.

## Two killed in road accidents

Two people were killed in separate road accidents in the city on Sunday.

Manzur Rahman, a garment worker, died 10 hours after he was run over by an autorickshaw near Kalyanpur bus stand at about 6.00pm. The driver sped away soon after the accident.

Manzur, 35, was rushed to Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) where he died at around 4.00am yesterday.

In the other incident, a speeding truck knocked down an unknown youth, aged around 30, at Atish Dipankar Road in Sabujbag, leaving him dead.

The youth was crossing the road when the truck hit him at around 9.00pm.
