



One shot dead in Chittagong

Agang of robbers shot one dead and injured two others at Chandanaish upazila in the district in the early hours of yesterday.

Badal Shil, 55, son of Sukanta Shil of Hayeedgaon under Paliya upazila, became the victim of the attack while visiting the house of his sister Pakhi Bala.

Police and witnesses said some fifteen armed robbers attacked the house of Pakhi Bala at Madhyam Hashimpur of Chandanaish at around 1:00am.

They decamped with the booty while firing at the chasing mob that left Badal and two-others bullet-hit.

Badal succumbed to his injury at Chittagong Medical College Hospital at around 5.30am.

A case was filed in this connection.

Eyes of criminal gouged out in Narayanganj
