A Glimpse to Palli Daridro Bimochon Foundation (PDBF)

PDBF is an independent and autonomous non-banking financial institution and a not-for-profit entity dedicated to the service of the rural poor and the disadvantaged. It was established by an Act of Parliament (Palli Daridro Bimochon Foundation Act, 1999) by transforming some CIDA (Canadian International Development Agency) funded bilateral projects (RD-12 and RBP/RBIP) implemented by Bangladesh Rural Development Board. By dint of the Act all the assets and liabilities including person power were transferred to PDBF in April 30, 2000, when PDBF started its journey.

The main objective of PDBF is to alleviate poverty and promoting the economic and social advancement of the rural poor and the disadvantaged including promoting gender equity and equality. Also PDBF is to attain financial and organizational sustainability by June 2008.

PDBF enjoys a unique legal status since it is neither an NGO nor a private company or government autonomous body. It is an independent organization governed by the 11-member Board of Governors (BOG) with a Managing Director as the Chief Executive. The clients have four representatives on the Board and another three members including the Chairperson represent Government. The rest three members are from private sector. Out of total 11, at least three members must be women. The Secretary, Rural Development and Co-operatives Division of the Ministry of LGRD & Co-operatives is the ex-officio Chairperson of the Board of Governors.

PDBF mobilizes rural poor and disadvantaged people into small groups/samities and provides them micro-credit and skill training for income generation and self-employment creation. It also raises awareness of its clients on human and legal rights, dowry, literacy, etc. and provides them other social development services for improvement of their social status. Furthermore, PDBF arranges other services like primary health care, sanitation, personal hygiene, adult literacy etc. for its clients through establishing effective linkages with other nation building organizations.

Results of last 4 years confirm that PDBF's achievement has been remarkable in mobilizing the rural poor men and women into groups/samities and in providing financial support, skill development training and other social services to empower them socially and economically. Currently PDBF is playing a leading role in the country's micro-credit sector by establishing best practices for micro credit management and operations. Some facts and figures are given below:
