2012 Olympics bid Cities to be shortlisted today

The nine cities hoping to stage the 2012 Olympic Games face a cull this week as Olympic chiefs meet to draw up a shortlist of candidates. The nine applicants -- Havana,

Istanbul, Leipzig, London, Madrid, Moscow, New York City, Paris and Rio de Janeiro -- will learn their fate on Tuesday.

Sources close to the International Olympic Committee believe the field is likely to be cut to as few as five.

However, the quality of the bids and the heavyweight nature of the applicants could see as many as seven cities go through to the next stage. The IOC will select the winning city

in July next year. While IOC president Jacques

Rogge said last year that he could envision all nine cities going through to a final round, sources now say some cities will definitely be cut.
