Agassi bids Paris bye

AFP, Paris

Former champion Andre Agassi suffered one of the most crushing defeats of his legendary career here on Monday when he crashed out of the French Open at the hands of French qualifier Jerome Haehnel who was playing his first ever match on the tour.

Sixth seed Agassi, the oldest man in the draw at 34, lost his first round encounter 6-4, 7-6, 6-3 in just over two hours on the Philippe Chatrier Court against a man ranked 271 in the world

There were no such problems, however, for defending women's champion Justine Henin-Hardenne who eased into the second round with a 6-4, 6-4 win over France's Sandrine Testud.

Agassi, the champion here in 1999, was looking to win his 800th career match but his campaign was sabotaged both by an opponent more used to playing satellite tours, as well as his poor preparation which had seen him play just once in the last two months

That outing too had ended in defeat in St Polten last week at the hands of unknown Serbian Nenad Zimonjic, ranked 339.

Agassi, one of only five men to have won all four Grand Slams, was playing in his 16th Roland Garros tournament having made his debut back in 1987 but he admitted that he was completely outplayed by the 23-year-old Frecnhman.
