Ensure access to justice to protect HR

Speakers tell workshop

Ensuring access to justice is a must for protection of human rights and overall development, speakers said at a workshop in the city yesterday.

Strengthening National Capacity to Promote and Protect Human Rights in Bangladesh, a project of the law ministry, organised the workshop on 'Access to Justice'.

Law Minister Moudud Ahmed said police and prison reforms and an effective investigation mechanism are prerequisites for protection of human rights

The police-people ratio in the country is 1:1300, he said, adding that 20 thousand police personne would soon be recruited to improve the law and order situation.

The minister said the judiciary has been functioning independ

"The High Court disposes of about 100 to 150 writ petitions every day and it proves that the judiciary is free and independent.

If any order of the executive infringes on the people's rights, it can be challenged in the Supreme Court, he said.

Responding to a question, the minister said, "Independence and separation of judiciary are two different things. We are working for the separation of judiciary."

"But the existing prosecution system is very weak as it takes a long time to dispose of a case," he said.
