Rift between BNP, Jamaat in Rajshahi

Nizami's visit cancelled

Ascheduled visit of Jamaat-e-Islami Ameer Matiur Rahman Nizami to Rajshahi has been cancelled following a rift between the local unit of Jamaat and the BNP.

The visit of Nizami, also the industries minister, on July 16 was cancelled for unavoidable reasons, said Rajshahi city Jamaat Ameer Prof Ataur Rahman in a statement yesterday.

The decision was taken at a meeting of Rajshahi city Jamaat on Sunday, he added.

The Jamaat and Islami Chhatra Shibir sources, however, said the visit was cancelled as the local leaders of BNP and Jamaat failed to repair the relationship that turned sour on July 3.

The enmity between the ruling alliance partners came to a head when their student wings -- Islami Chhatra Shibir and Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal -- were locked in a gunfight at Rajshahi Polytechnic Institute over election of the students' union.

The Jamaat and Shibir circulated leaflets and put up posters, blaming some BNP and JCD leaders for the gunfight while BNP leaders in a statement called on the Jamaat to keep the Shibir cadres under control.

Rajshahi city and district units of the Jatiyatabadi Jubo Dal, youth front of the ruling BNP, in a joint statement said that the relationship between the BNP and the Jamaat has been damaged since the gunfight.

"Peace at every educational institution will be affected if the Jamaat continues to protect its cadres," said the statement.

The Shibir and JCD leaders filed at least eight cases over the gunfight that left some 30 Shibir cadres and eight JCD cadres injured.

A senior police official said that leaders of both BNP and Jamaat were lobbying for arresting the accused.

"But we are still waiting for a reconciliation. Otherwise, more violence may take place," he said.

56 shops fined for using polybags

BSS, Dhaka

Environment and Forests Minister Tariqul Islam yesterday led the anti-polybags drive at different shopping centres and groceries where a huge quantity of polythene shopping bags and a bag making machine were seized.

Owners of 56 shops were fined Tk 41,500 for using polybag during the drive.

State Minister for Environment and Forests Jafrul Islam Chowdhury accompanied Tariqul during the drive at Fakirerpool and

Shantinagar grocery markets, third of its kind in a week in the city. Thirty ministry officials, a mobile court and two platoons of police took part in the drive.

Earlier, similar drives were carried out at the New Market, Mohammadpur, Gulshan and Mohakhali grocery markets.

Death threats by fanatics condemned

Different political parties and professional organisations yesterday condemned the death threats issued by an Islamist outfit to political leaders, journalists and intellectuals.

They also demanded arrest of and exemplary punishment to the persons responsible.

The Islamist outfit, Mujahideen al-Islam, issued death threats to 10 prominent politicians, intellectuals and journalists on Sunday accusing them of acting against Islam and its efforts to turn Bangladesh into an Islamic state.

Protesting the death threats, the leaders of Workers Party of Bangladesh urged the non-communal, progressive and democratic forces to come forward to protect the country from the Islamist zealots.

They also called on the people to unite to topple the BNP-Jamaat alliance government.

In a statement, the Committee

for Eliminating the Killers and Collaborators of '71 said the government has turned a blind eye to the activities of the militant groups, encouraging them to be more violent.

The signatories to the statement included National Professor Kabir Chowdhury, Barrister Shawkat Ali Khan, Advocate Gaziul Haque, journalist Kamal Lohani, Prof Panna Kaiser and artists Rafiqun Nabi and Hashem Khan.

In another statement, Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) said progressive teachers, journalists and political activists are the targets of the attack, but the government is not taking any step against the fanatics.

The DUTA also demanded security for Prof Abul Barakat, Muntazir Mamun, MM Akash, Humayun Azad and other teachers and political activists.

Ain O Salish Kendra (ASK) said the law and order situation has deteriorated alarmingly and nobody has security of life.
