4 get life in Faruq murder case

A court in Dhaka yesterday awarded life imprisonment to four persons in Arman Hossain Faruq murder case in the city.

The convicts are Rustum, Bashir, Sultan and Kamal.

The court also fined them Tk 20,000 each, in default, to suffer two years more in jail.

Shamsul Alam Khan, the sessions judge of third additional metropolitan court, however, acquitted 10 others.

They are Tota, Amir Hossain, Harun, Arman, Khokan, Mohammad Javed, Bahauddin, Kiamu, Ejaj and Reaz Uddin.

According to the prosecution, the

convicts chopped Arman Hossain Faruq to death on February 9, 2000 as he resisted the abduction of a girl.

Arman was sleeping along with his wife and children at his house on the night of the incident. He came out of the house after hearing the noise and entered altercations with the criminals who chopped him seriously.

Faruq was rushed to Dhaka Medical College Hospital where he succumbed to his injuries.

Mohammad Feroz, brother of Faruq, filed a case accusing eight persons for the murder.

The investigating officer pressed charges against 14 people.

The court took deposition of 14 witnesses during the hearing.

Assistant Public Prosecutor Advocate Shahidul Islam appeared on behalf of the government while Advocate Abdul Wadud Bhuiyan pleaded for the accused.

President assents to two bills

Situation tense at Kuet

Tension is prevailing on the Khulna University of Engineering and Technology (Kuet) campus as students have been agitating for press home their demand for removal of acting Registrar Dr ANM Mizanur Rahman.

Chhatra Adhikar Shangrakkhon Sangram Parishad press release said that Dr Mizan, also head of the Mechanical Engineering department, appointed persons of his choice and relatives in different posts illegally.

We are on agitation to press home our seven-point demand, said Sangram Parishad President Habibur Rahman Hillool. He threatened to paralyse academic and administrative activities if the acting

registrar was not removed immediately. When asked Dr Mizan refuted allegation of nepotism. What I did was done with the consent of selection committee, he said.

Meanwhile, the students brought out a procession on the campus yesterday to press home their demand.

Husband strangles wife

A husband allegedly strangled his wife inside their house at Dewan Bari Slum in Mirpur in the city yesterday.

Police recovered the body of Shefali Begum, 25, with a black stain around her neck.

Neighbours said Hafizul Sheikh, a mason, beat his wife mercilessly following a quarrel on Saturday night.

They found Shefali's body on the floor with blood oozing from her nose and mouth yesterday morning, said Mohammad Amin, a neighbour of the victim.

Hafizul went on hiding with his two-year-old son and six-year-old daughter after the killing.

Hafizul and Shefali got married seven years back following an affair.

The victim's brother Reazul fled a murder case with Mirpur Police Station in this regard.

1623 more held

UNB, Dhaka

Police arrested 1,623 people on various charges during their country-wide drive in last 24 hours till 6.00am yesterday.

During the drive, the law enforcers also recovered five firearms, two other weapons and four bullets and filed three cases against 10 people under the Arms Act, said a Police Headquarters press release.
