

Dutch instt to provide fund for DU women's studies deptt

BSS, Dhaka

An agreement between the University of Dhaka and the Hague-based Institute of Social Studies (ISS), Netherlands was signed here yesterday.

Under the agreement, the Women's Studies Department of DU will receive funds from the ISS for its institutional development on a comprehensive scale, a DU press release said.

The fund will be utilised under a project entitled 'Institutionalising the Department of Women's Studies, University of Dhaka, Bangladesh', to improve the institutional capacity through various training programmes and fellowships for Masters and Ph.D degrees.

The project also offers opportunities for the post-doctoral fellowships as well as regional and international networking and collaboration.

Logistic support and teaching aids, library resources and internet facilities are being provided to contribute to teaching and research on areas relating to women and gender issues, the press release added.

It said the project would also enable the department to offer scholarship, internship and exchange

programmes to students. The five-year project also provides facilities for various project personnel, including faculty, during the period.

Treasurer of Dhaka University Professor Syed Rashidul Hasan signed the agreement on behalf of DU, Vice-Chancellor Professor SMA Faiz, Pro Vice-Chancellor Professor AFM Yusuf Haider, Dutch Ambassador to Bangladesh Sjeijersema, Professor Harun-or-Rashid, Dr Najma Chowdhury, Dr Nazmunnissa Mahtab, chairman of the Department of women's Studies, were also present.

Dr J B Opschoor, Rector, ISS, will sign the agreement on behalf of the Institute at the Netherlands later.

The Rajshahi Krishi Unnayan Bank (RAKUB) has floated a high-level monitoring cell to help the flood victims in northwestern districts.

The affected borrowers would be given fresh loans soon after the recession of flood water to overcome the losses, the sources said.

All officers and employees of the bank have been advised to stand by the flood affected people as per the directive of the Finance and Planning Minister M Saifur Rahman.

Cancellation of all illegal appointments at CU demanded

General Students Council against Corruption and Irregularities (GSCCI), a newly floated student forum at Chittagong University (CU), has demanded immediate cancellation of all illegal appointments including the recent one in finance department.

"The vice chancellor has been appointing teachers and employees defying the existing university rule," said the council leaders.

At an emergency meeting at the Chittagong University Central Student Union (CUCSU) Building premises, the council held the Vice Chancellor Prof AJM Nuruddin Chowdhury responsible for all illegal appointments.

The council, reportedly backed by Jatiyatabdhi Chhatra Dal (JCD), also urged the VC to cancel the appointment of Zahirul Haq.

vowed to go for a greater agitation after the reopening of the university on August 1 if the appointment of Dr Zahirul Haq as the head of finance department violating the seniority rule is not cancelled by that time.

"The vice chancellor has been appointing teachers and employees defying the existing university rule," said the council leaders.

Convenor Abu Shabat Mohammad Sayem, Matiur Rahman, Sagar, M Sohag and Shahjahan also spoke.
