Bangladesh Non-government Primary Teachers' Association yesterday vowed to continue their ongoing strike until the government accepts their demand for nationalisation of their jobs.

Thousands of agitating teachers from different parts of the country took the vow at a grand rally at the Central Shaheed Minar.

"It is we who build the nation by teaching our people, but we are now the most deprived section of the society," said Association Secretary General Akkas Ali Sheikh.

Association Organising Secretary Aminul Islam said the prime minis-

ter should accept the demand of non-government teachers as it was the election pledge of her party.

Delwar Hossain, a teacher from Noakhali, said the government and non-government teachers are performing the same functions although there is a huge discrimination in salary

"How could one expect a better service from non-government teachers when they are given only Tk 1,950 per month? " Shaheb Ali, a teacher from Rangpur posed the question.
