### HC rejects writ against takeover

A division bench of the High Court (HC) comprising Justice Joydul Abedin and Justice Sarifuddin Chaklader yesterday rejected the writ petition of the managing authority of the Barisal Planet World Children Park against its takeover by Barisal City Corporation (BCC).

The bench rejected the prayer as applicant did not file any case about the breach of contract against the BCC at lower court before coming to the higher court.

Barrister Rokan Uddin Mahmud and Advocate Mushfiqur Rahman placed the submission in favour of the applicant while Advocate Joydul Abedin defended the BCC.

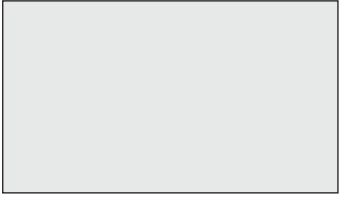
### Filing of 'false case' protested

Assistant Secretary of the central sub-committee of Awami League (AL) Nasrul Hamid Bipu yesterday protested the filing of a false case against Awami Swechchhasebok League (ASL) and Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) leaders of Keraniganj thana unit.
