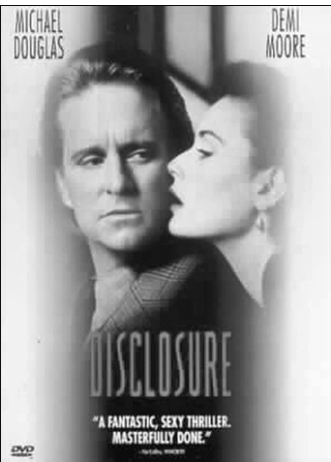

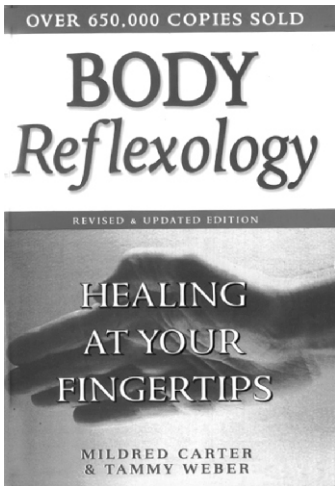


**The Gathering Storm** (IMDb rating 7.4)

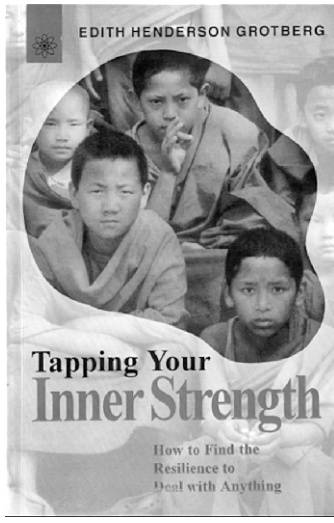
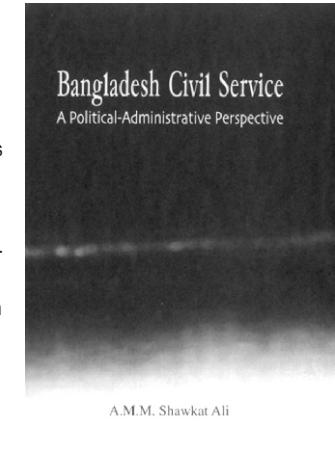
**Perspectives on Flood 1998**

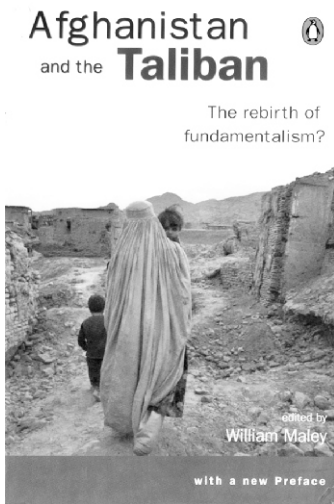
**Rani Kanchan Mala and Other Stories**

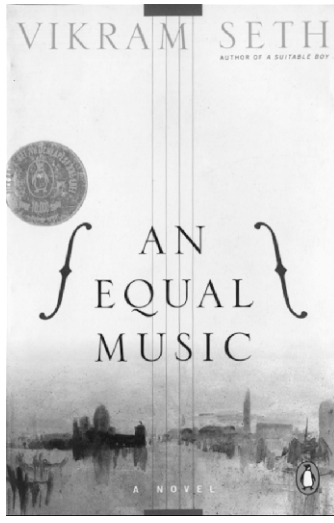

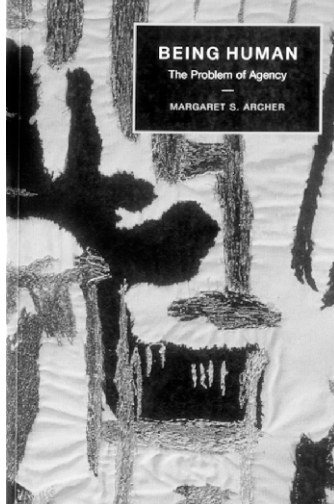
**Tapping Your Inner Strength**

First it seized the southern city of Kandahar, then in 1995 it took over the ancient city of Herat, and finally, in September 1996, the capital Kabul fell to its forces. The Taliban enforced rigorous Sharia laws and restricted the employment and movement of women under a strict Islamic regime. Its draconian religious decrees and public executions of political opponents and criminals immediately captured world attention. Yet much about the Taliban remains mysterious.

**A Sound Guide to the Birds of Bangladesh**

Bird calls are an integral part of the bird identification process. On occasions, a call of a bird may be the only means available for positively identifying a bird in the field without the help of a mist net. Most birds have three distinct call categories, such as contact call, alarm call, and mating call. Contact calls are often the routine call of most birds, and used between a pair or group of same species for communication. While alarm call of any bird is almost universal in nature, and understood among different species. Some species of birds are silent throughout the year except the breeding period, when they can become extremely loud and vocal, while some will have an altogether different call during this period. Therefore all these and many other factors may determine the nature of a bird call in any given period of the year.
