
Jibanananda Das Short Fiction, 1931-33

libanananda Das (1899-1954) was perhaps the most important Bengali noet after Tagore However, the discovery of his unpubished manuscripts and their corpus of some eighty short stories and five novels that far exceeds in volume the original poetic canon, and has opened a new window on the literary career of Jibnananda. 1931-1933 but published only from the 1980s. Selected from the stories are a representative sample compelling style and of his insistent concern with time, memory, included here are nearly autobiographical, and they provide an libanananda, the poet. Moreover, a short story writer, Jibanananda expands the scope of Bengali prose


