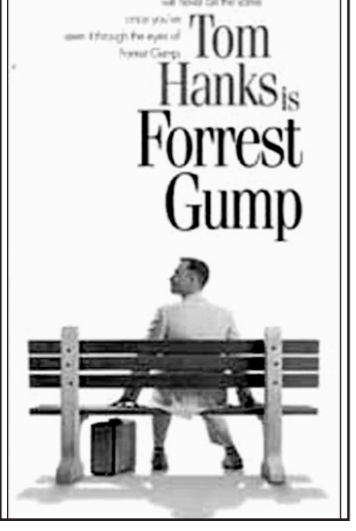

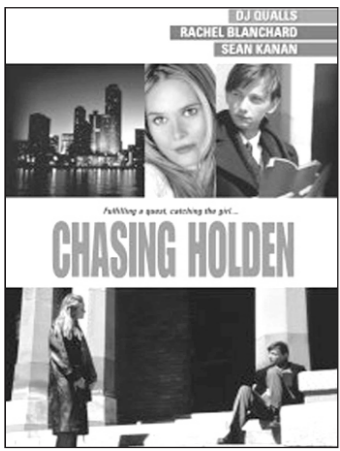
**Hannibal** (IMDb rating 6.2)

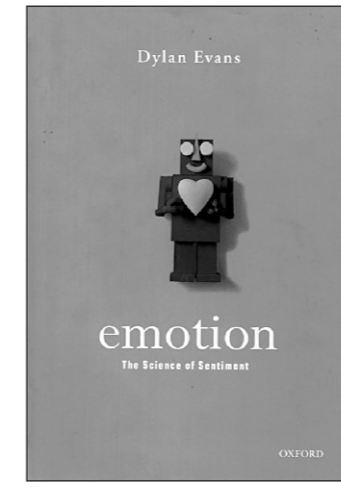
**History of Sanskrit Poetics**

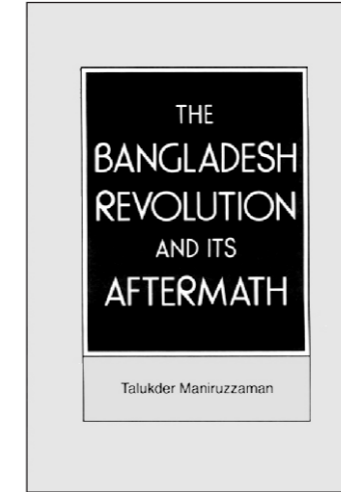
**Muntassir Mamun**
