Career and Employment Service

The Careers and Employment Service assists students with a variety of matters relating to career management such as course planning, employment prospects, career choice decisions, job search strategies and further study options. Assistance is available via personal appointment or through group workshops and seminars. There is also a self-access Careers Resource Center which has a variety of career related information in printed, audio-visual and computerized form. Interactive computerized careers guidance programs are available as well.

Canteen and Cafeteria Facility

There is an arrangement for a students canteen and a teachers canteen for provision of foods, snacks and soft drinks, so that one can take according to one's need on cash payment.

Higher Study Contact Facility

NUB provides higher study contact facilities for the benefit of its students and their prospective future life. This services of the University arranges stipends and guides them for higher study. The placement office maintains records of students of the University and these records are made available to the prospective employers.

Credit Transfer Facility

Academic degrees and Diplomas of NUB is widely recognized by the universities in the UK, Canada, Australia & North American. Students of NUB can easily transfer their credits to any University of the world.

Special Language Program

To cope with demand of English language proficiency, the University offers a separate Basic English Development Course for the students. It is designed for the fresher for educational and conversational purposes. It is an intensive course before entering into the respective academic program of study which will enable students to pursue the academic course smoothly. The language program is offered to meet the practical demand of the students to make them capable of speaking and writing English for academic and communicative purposes.

A: THE UNIVERSITY

Northern University, Bangladesh (NUB) is a government approved private university having fulfilled the requirements as laid down in the Private University Act 1992, which has been sponsored and founded by IBAT Trust. The Trust is gov. registered non-political and non-profit organization. The members of IBAT Trust who are mostly eminent academics felt the need for a private university to bring the quality education within the reach of students with a modest economic means. Therefore, it stands unique among the private universities in Bangladesh.

Class Room Facilities

The classrooms are well-equipped with world class learning environment including air-coolers, overhead projector and multimedia projection with internet facilities.

Computer Lab & Internet Facilities

The NUB is dedicated to providing the most modern facilities both in terms of hardware and software and is committed to upgrading these facilities to keep pace with changing technology. Its computer labs are equipped with built-in-media connected to HP Net Server E 800 Windows NT local area network (LAN). At the computer lab, the provision is available for one computer for each student. Computers are connected to a host of other peripheral devices such as scanner, printer, digital cameras etc. Internet facilities are available at all work-stations through broadband connection.



Library Services

NUB has well stocked Library that has:

- Over twenty thousands books on various subject related topics.
- CDs on management topics and self-improvement.
- Audiocassettes on management.
- Hundreds of project reports done by past students on various management subjects.
- NUB also subscribes the major magazines, journals both national and international.
- A group of professional and knowledgeable staff are always available at the library
- The NUB library is open until 9.00 p.m. every day.

The library provides up-to-date information to students, researchers and teachers. It has an open-stack easy access system that encourages students to use the facilities.

Job Placement Services

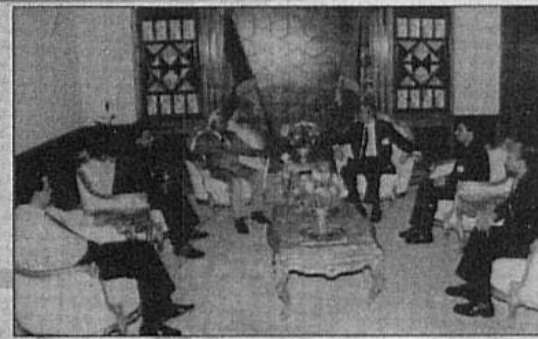
NUB operates a placement office for the benefit of its students and their prospective employers. The placement service includes in arranging interviews for the graduates and their prospective employers to meet and discuss mutual interests. The placement office maintains records of the graduating students of the university and these records are made available to the prospective employers for the purpose.

Student Advising

All student entering NUB as freshman are assigned to an academic advisor who will be responsible for guiding and helping all academic matters including in choosing their courses through out the study at NUB. Students will develop the direction of their study in consultation with their advisor.

Internship Program

In order to acquaint the practical awareness about the office management and industrial systems students are provided industrial attachment for a period shall be arranged by the University. This attachment program usually be held at the related industry and other co companies including banks, insurance companies, national & multinational companies and NGOs. For certain program of study, an industrial tour may also be arranged.
