Land crisis and disputes forced the Dhaka City Corporation (DCC) to curtail its plan to construct 100 public toilets in the

The Asian Development Bank (ADB) is financing the \$10 lakh ones. Urban Primary Health Care Project (UPHCP) aiming to improve sanitation facilities for the city

Construction of the public toilets started at the beginning of this year and the project is scheduled to complete by the end of

But DCC had to drop construction of 30 out of 100 public toilets

due to non-availability of land. Construction of another 10-15 toilets is uncertain due to land

Sources said land crisis has compelled the authorities to renovate some old public toilets instead of constructing new

The city of 10 million people has a very few public toilets, most of which has been captured by criminals who do not pay lease money to the DCC on regular

It is difficult for people to get inside the public toilets as most of these lavatories go under criminals' control after dusk that forces people to discharge excreta under open sky.

"I never used a public toilet as these always remain in dirty and unhygienic condition due to poor maintenance," said Jamil Ahmed, a resident of Kalabagan

"Sometimes passersby face great problem to find out a public toilet as such toilets are not easily seen from main roads," Jamil


Dr Azizul Haque, chief health officer of DCC, also pointed out that it was difficult to maintain cleanliness in the city without sufficient number of public toi-

"Seventy public toilets is not enough for a city like Dhaka where more than one crore people reside. We would like to construct more public toilets but where is the land?"

Regarding the land crisis, an official of DCC estate department said they have no budget to buy land for construction of public

"It is not possible to construct public toilets buying lands as it involves huge amount of money," the official said requesting ano-

When asked about land disputes in construction of public toilets, the official said they would settle the land disputes

Water crisis dogging Rayerbazar residents

Residents of Rayerbazar,' Sultanganj and their environs in Bangla Sadak are struggling through a seven-month water crisis, which still persists during Ramadan.

"The crisis is getting worse with time but the authorities have not solved the problem as yet," said Abbas Chowdhury, a resident of

Residents said the problem began immediately after replacements of some old water-pipes in

Water was previously supplied under extreme difficulties from three other pumps in Tali office, ters on Road No. 15 in Dhanmondi. But the new pipes with larger diameters have further slimmed the possibility of an adequate water supply.

The authorities cited a large number of illegal subscribers as a potential reason.

"Many subscribers did not pay bills but linked their water tanks to our pipes," said an official for the Zone 3, Dhaka Water and Sewerage Authority (Wasa), in Lalmatia.

"We have to buy 1,500 litres of water available at Wasa almost regularly to carry on with our daily chores," said another resident.

Each tank costs about Tk150 and finishes in two days. The poorer families suffer most, while some chip in whatever little they have to buy water in gallons, said another resident.
