Three sisters killed in road accident

Three sisters were killed and two other people injured when a Dhaka-bound bus hit their autorickshaw in Comilla yesterday afternoon. Fourteen-year-old Shab-e-Barat died in the spot while her elder sisters Sonia Akhtar, 18, and Nusrat Akhtar, 16, died after they were brought to Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) at around 6.00pm. Critically injured Kazi Nesar Ahmed, the victims' brother-in-law, and 16-year-old Roksana, their cousin, are undergoing treatment at a local clinic in Comilla and in the DMCH.

93 child workers rescued from Dublar Char
BSS, Dhaka
Members of Bangladesh Coastguard rescued 93 child workers from the Sundarbans in two weeks and seized stolen and smuggled goods including timbers worth around Tk 35 lakh. On a tip off, a team of western zone coastguard conducted a drive at Dublar Char fishermen village in the Sundarbans and rescued the child workers from there. The rescued children were handed over to their guardians after bringing them to the Mongla Port, a press release said. Police arrested a person from Mongla bus stand for his alleged involvement in smuggling of the children. The coastguard seized commodities, including 66,240 pieces of National and Toshiba batteries and spares worth Tk 7,48,000 colour televisions, and CD cassettes worth Tk 3,09,000, alcohol worth Tk 9,000, scrap iron worth Tk 25,000 and various wood worth Tk 9,10,000, the release added.

Concern over dowry violence

Bangladesh Society for the Enforcement of Human Rights (BSEHR) yesterday expressed deep concern over the rise in dowry-related violence across the country. In a statement, BSEHR Secretary General Sigma Huda and Executive Director Alena Khan also protested the killing of a housewife for dowry at Bogra. The 32-year-old housewife, Fency Khatun, a resident of Noongola village, was beaten to death at the night of Eid-ul-Fitr. Dowry is spreading like cancer in the society, they said. Although the government has taken drastic steps to curb dowry-related violence, such heinous acts are still taking place, they added.
