15,000 flats for city's low income people

Government is going to build 15,000 flats at city's Bhasantak area for slum-dwellers, low-income and landless people with a view to solving housing problems in the capital.

Government has taken this project at a cost of about Tk three crore under the Ministry of Land.

Five thousand flats will be distributed within next two years among the shelterless people in the capital, Deputy Minister for Land Advocate Ruhul Kuddus Talukder (Dulu) said at a press conference on 'Land Management in Bangladesh' at the Reporters' Unity Auditorium in the city yesterday.

Government has also begun the process of collecting tax through banks replacing the old process in order to free people from harassment by tashildars.

"Experimentally, we have already implemented this process at six upazilas in six divisions. As the result of this process is positive, we will soon begin this process across the country," said Ukil Abdus Sattar Bhuiyan, State Minister for Land addressing the press conference.

These six upazilas are Pabna in Rajshahi, Sathkhira Sadar in Khulna, Barisal Sadar in Barisal, Hathazari in Chittagong, Sylhet Sadar in Sylhet and Shibpur in Dhaka division.

People in the capital will soon get the opportunity to appeal to court for amending errors during the previous land survey, as law ministry

is going to pass law for this, the state minister said.

Government has taken special steps to drive out the encroachers from the capital and media can play vital role in this issue, he added.

Meanwhile, the land ministry has donated land for some reporters playing important role through writing in different media about various problems in the society and the ministry will also build flats for solving their housing problem.

Four killed in road accident

Four people were killed in a road accident on the Dhaka-Chittagong highway near Batabaria under Sadar upazila early yesterday.

The dead are Khalilur Rahman, 40, Joynal Abedin, 15, Hasina Begum, 30, and her one-year-old daughter Tamanna of Rajballabpur village under Chaudhogram upazila of Comilla.

They were returning home from Sylhet on board a truck that met with the accident at about 3:00am.

Police said the mishap took place when the Chittagong bound truck skidded off the highway and fell into a ditch, killing the four on the spot.

Police seized the vehicle, but its driver and helper managed to flee.

'Ensure medico-legal test at local level'

Ensure immediate medico-legal test of the rape victims at local level, demanded the speakers at a press conference yesterday.

They said the government issued a circular on September 16, 2002 directing the upazila health complexes to start medico-legal test of the rape victim.

But a recent survey conducted by the Naripakko revealed that of the

36 upazila health complexes in 11 districts, only 10 are aware of the circular, they added.

The press conference was organised by Naripakko, a non-government organisation, on the eve of the International Day of Non-Violence Against Women in the city.

In a keynote paper, Kamrunnahar, project manager of Naripakko said the worst manifestation of violence against a woman is rape, and a quick medico-legal test is a

must to prove that a girl has been violated.

So it is very important to send the government circular to every upazila health complex immediately and make the people aware about it, she added.

Dr Jesmine Ara Sultana of Thengamara Mahila Sabuj Sangha, Motijan Bibi of Adarsa Mahila Seba Sangsta, Ratna Yasmin of Durbar Network and Rashida Hossain of Naripakko also spoke.
