
# Poetry collection of Shamsur Rahman launched

HE November 2 evening at the Liberation War Museum was a nostalgic one as intellectuals of the country reminisced on the best contemporary Bangla poet Shamsur Rahman. The occasion was the launching of Somoy Prakashan's collection of the poet's poems Shera Shamsur Rahman (Best of Shamsur Rahman) to celebrate his 75th birth anniversary. The book is edited by Saleh Chowdhury. Mustafa Nurul Islam, Zillur Rahman Siddiqui, Nirmalendu Goon, Humayun Ahmed spoke at the programme presided over by ABM

'Fond readers are the worst edi-tors as it is hard for them to select the best out of one's complete works,' asserted Saleh Chowdhury. 'Although not all poems of a poet are best, but Shamsur Rahman is exceptional. Many creations of the poet have been lost in time, especially his translations of the poems of Khwaja Farid. Only 41 songs the poet has written are found out of almost 250, he informed.

'When we were drifted away from the romantic poets like Jibanananda Das and Buddhadev Basu and inspired by the poems of Sukanta Bhattacharya, Subhash Mukhopadhyay, Nazim Hikmet and the Russian poet Vladimir Mayakovoski during 1947-'48, Shamsur Rahman came to the scene. His Telemachus, Asader Shirt, Bornomala, Amar Dukhini

earned timeless appeal. His famous lines like Choter porda shoriye dekhi kothay achhi depict the turmoil of our present time. Or, through the line Udbhot uter pithey cholechhey swadesh we can realise the situation of the whole Bangla', said a nostalgic Mustafa Nurul Islam.

Nirmalendu Goon, Humayun Ahmed, Zillur Rahaman Siddigui and ABM Musa pointed out different facets of the poet that reveal his atTk.500. versatility as a translator, lyricist and novelist apart from his poetic

identity. Shera Shamsur Rahman contains 122 poems, two novels, two short stories, 38 essays, 26 rhymes, 41 songs, memoirs, letters and excerpts of an interview taken by

## Shangkhonad earns applause at première

The third day of the ongoing 2nd International Film Festival featured première of reputed filmmaker Abu Sayeed's film Shangkhonad. One of the contesting films at the festival, Sayeed's second feature film Shangkhonad is based on popular writer Nasrin Jahan's novel titled Urey Jaay Nishi Pokkhi.

The story depicts the conse-


quences of a youth's return after a long time to his roots--a village named Nayanpur of Bogra district, where he was born and spent his childhood. The film begins with the 37-year old Osman's arrival at the village rail station. Osman, whose childhood name was Chand, sets for his village home on a stormy night by boat rowed by an adolescent boatman named Qutubuddin. The boat capsizes in the inclement weather

and the young boatman drowns and later dies. Villagers dislike Osman blaming that he was responsible for Outub's death. However, influential Mannaf Khan, whose father killed Osman's parents and grabbed all their landed properties, gives Osman shelter without knowing his identity. Lonely Osman often speaks out his childhood memories and recog-

nises his friend Fazlu who used to say he would become a bandit. Osman also finds out the Kujo Buri, a hunchback black magic practitioner, whom Osman used to call 'Dudh Ma' (foster mother). She also recognises Osman. These baffle Mannaf Khan, who gradually comes to learn about Osman's identity. Mannaf Khan becomes worried about his image in case the whole village comes to learn Osman's real identity. For, he wants to contest in the next chairman elections. So he hires Fazlu, who is a burial cloth thief, to take Osman to a distant island where Mannaf's men kill both of them.

Made in 35mm format, Mahfuzur Rahman Kahn's cinematography is praiseworthy. However, what has made the 102-minute film successful is Abu Sayeed's use of symbolic shots. When Osman writes the famous line 'through death Kadambini proved that she did not die' from Rabindranath Tagore's story Jibito O Mrito, it becomes a symbolic suggestion of Osman's own death.

Among the performers, Fazlur Rahman Babu is excellent in his role of Fazlu. Besides, Zahid Hasan plays the lead role of Osman, KS Firoz plays Mannaf Khan and Najma Anowar plays Kujo Buri. The music by SI Tutul is another praiseworthy feature of

# Shah Rukh Khan lends his voice to a children's film

Almost every time actor Shah Rukh Khan has appeared on the big screen in his 15-year-old career in Bollywood, he has worked magic at the box office.

Now, he is seeking to do the same in a different way: by lending his voice. And in this new role, his son Aryan accompanies him. The father and son have lent their voices to two animated characters in the Hindi version of worldwide hit animation The Incredibles directed by Brad Bird. The Hindi version is slated for commercial release in India this month.

While Khan the senior has lent his voice to the central character of The Incredibles, the junior Khan has dubbed the voice of Tej, the son of the screen father.

Shah Rukh is quite excited about his new assignment. He said in newspaper interviews that he was happy to lend his voice to the film, which is in the category of children's movies, and help popularise

Given that a number of top Hollywood stars have lent their voices to characters in animated films, the actor wanted to give a try in the same exercise. What was the difference he found in dubbing for films in which he acts and the one for the Hindi version of The Incredible? In his view, in the first category the actor knows the situations and the characters already enacted before the camera and accordingly recreates the emotions. However, it is quite different in the second category where the actor dubs for somebody else.



## CELEBRATING THE HARVEST




