SSKOP threatens strike on Dec 26

Sangbadik Sramik Karmachari Oikya Parishad (SSKOP) yesterday threatened to go for a 24-hour strike in all newspapers and news agencies on December 26 if its seven-point demand, including formation of the sixth wage board, was not met by December 25.

The SSKOP at a meeting also announced that a grand rally of journalists, press workers and employees will be held at the National Press Club at 11:00am on December 26.

It also decided that joint meetings of the Oikya Parishad would be held in all newspaper and news agency offices from December 15 to 25 to make the strike a success, says a press release.

The parishad also condemned the authorities concerned for not taking action against the newspaper owners who had not implemented the 5th Wage Board Award yet.

SSKOP leaders Gias Kamal Chowdhury, Iqbal Sobhan Chowdhury, Md Fazole Imam, Ruhul Amin Gazi, Motiur Rahman Talukdar and Monjurul Ahsan Bulbul were present at the meeting.

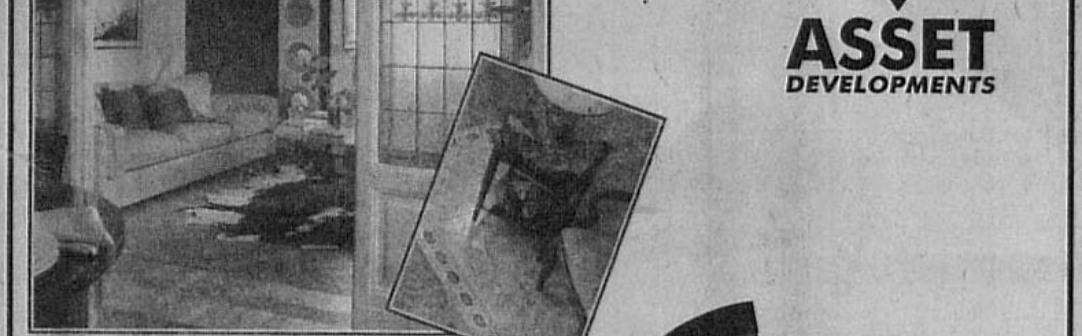
