5 to die, 8 get life

Trader gunned down

A tribunal here yesterday sentenced five people to death and eight others to life imprisonment in the sensational triple murder case of Hathazari.

The court acquitted 10 others as the charges brought against them were not proved while one died during the trial.

The convicts with death are Kazi Mobarak Hossain, Mohammad Osman, Moinuddin alias Battaiya, Imam Uddin alias Mujib and Mohammad Lokman while Mohammad Baktiar alias Nonaiya, former local UP chairman Abul Kalam Chowdhury, Mohammad Belal, Jamal Uddin alias Karate Mohammad Shahjahan, Shah Alam, Mohammad Doulat Uddin alias Rasel and Abu Rashed were given life in jail.
