CHOBI MELA III.

Small Spaces, Big Dreams

Singaporean photographer presents the modern-life dilemma

HRISYap's presentation of his subject--Small Spaces, Big Dreams--at Drik Gallery as part of the ongoing Chobi Mela III is very interesting. A symmetrically presented collage in style, the display brings in the photographer's subject in the small space of the frame--corresponding to its title.

Yap believes that 'human beings are born with an innate resistance to the changes around'. 'While we constantly hear about people caving in under pressure--be it physical or spiritual--we don't give in easily,' he says. The modern life necessitates space having 'multitude of uses, simultaneously or otherwise'. And just keeping that in mind, Yap presents nine different shots on a single canvas portraying the 'multitude of uses' brilliantly.

'In land-scarce Singapore, we learn to deal with limits in living spaces,' Yap explains. 'The void deck below the public housing blocks is a place for both living and dying.'The bathroom can be a private sanctuary. The home is a workplace, and a workplace is often more hospitable than home,' says Yap. His canvas presents glimpses of the living room, kitchen, balcony, bathroom and portico, among others.

The collage projects the continuous litany--'Make space, make space', but it also reflects the conviction of the city-dwellers--'We are resistant.'

The exhibition runs till December 23, the closing day of Chobi Mela III.

Ferdousi Rahman a singer of repute, stepped into the world of music as a young girl of six. She has been a major figure in the cultural scenario for more than 50 years. The Daily Star met up with the eminent singer recently. Excerpts:

What's your nickname? Mirna-it's a Russian name. What keeps you going?

Music -- and more music. I feel that throughout my career--first as a singer and later as a teacher-- I was blessed.

The programme, which I conducted on children, Esho Gaan Shikhi is still popular. With a gap of two years I have been training the young talents on TV from the very inception. Khan Ataur Rahman, Azad Rahman and a few others have occasionally conducted the programme, but somehow people have always admired my way of presentation.

What's the sweetest thing about you? People often ask how I manage to smile all the time and enliven the atmosphere wherever I go.Itakethatasacompliment.

What is the worst thing about you? Nowadays, I get agitated quite fast and get nse over trivial matters. What interests you other than music?

I take great interest in designing saris for myself. In doing so, I find that our deshi materi-als are fun to work on. I also love to experiment with new dishes at regular intervals. In addition, I am into interior designing.

Any hilarious experience you would like to share with us?

During the early '60s, we were quite used to live broadcasts from the radio. And there were times when we had amusing experiences as well. At Shahbag radio station, we were performing for some special event. Big names like Laila Arjumand Banu, Rawshan Ara Masud and many others were also performing. All of a sudden, Rawshan Ara Masud began to giggle over something. As you know laughing is con-tagious, and it was impossible for us to stop laughing. Abdul Ahad, our music director, looked at us helplessly from the other side of the glass. Somehow, we managed to finish the song and we all sighed with relief at the end.

What are your memorable experiences? During my long career, I have had the privilege to work with great composers such as Abdul Ahad, Sattya Shaha, Samar Das, Khalil Anand, Nisar Bazmi and many more. As artistes, we utilised our time optimally. Even while travelling through the mountainous regions of Muree during our musical tours abroad, on a bus, I remember taking lessons from the classi-

cal maestros Nazakat Ali and Salamat Ali. Your first play back/superhit playback My first playback was a famous bhawaiya O Mor Kala Rey Kala for the film Aasia, in 1958. The song Poraney dola dilo ekon bhromora for the film Sutorang, directed by Subash Dutt, composed by Sattya Saha was the first superhit song out of over 1,000 songs I have sung play-

What are your prestigious awards?

I have been awarded with many prestigious awards like the Ekushey Padak and the Swadhinata Padak--- but the most important thing to me is the love of my ardent fans.

Mohammad Bari is the founder General Secretary of the theatre troupe-- Theatre Art Unit. Initially he started his theatre activities with Dhaka Padatik in 1989. Later, along with eminent theatre personality of the country-- SM Solaiman--he formed Theatre Art Unit on October 22,

The ongoing drama festival is their third effort. Earlier the troupe arranged two festivals in 1992 and in 1998. Of the 12 productions of the group Mohammad Bari has performed in all the plays except Golapjan, which is a solo performance by the protagonist-- Golapjan. Last year, their latest production Trinoporne Shalmonjori won the best stage drama award and Bari played a vital role in the play. He is one of the major cast members of the play Court Martial which has already completed the 150-show

Following the death of SM Solaiman, Bari is now bearing the responsibility of the director for the play-- Court Martial. As the co-convenor of the current festival, Bari says, 'It is difficult to arrange a festival, particularly bringing theatre groups from other countries. Cultural activities in Bangladesh need promotion. The festival has been arranged in the most modern and expensive theatre hall in the country. We are proud of the arrangement, since this is the first time that we are organising a festival in the

others perform in the play.


Swades lights up the silver screen

Three years ago, Bollywood director Asutosh Gowarikar had set the box office on fire and won an Oscar nomination for his film Lagaan, starring Aamir Khan in the lead role. And now he is back to his roots with the com-mercial release of his much-hyped Swades featuring another Khan and Bollywood's safest box-office bet Shah Rukh Khan.

There are certain things common between Lagaan and Swades: internationally-feted Allah Rakha Rahman is the music director of both, the two films are set in a village and deal with thought-provoking issues, the heroines in both the movies (Gracy Singh in the earlier and Gayatri Joshi in the second) make their screen debut.

But the similarities end there. Lagaan, set in pre-Independence India, was action-packed and revolved around a one-day cricket match. Swades, on the other hand, portraying the story of an Indian engineer (played by Shah Rukh
