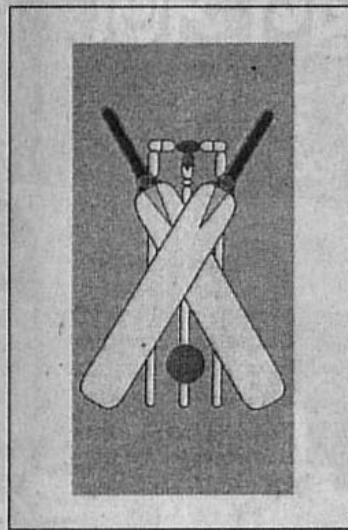

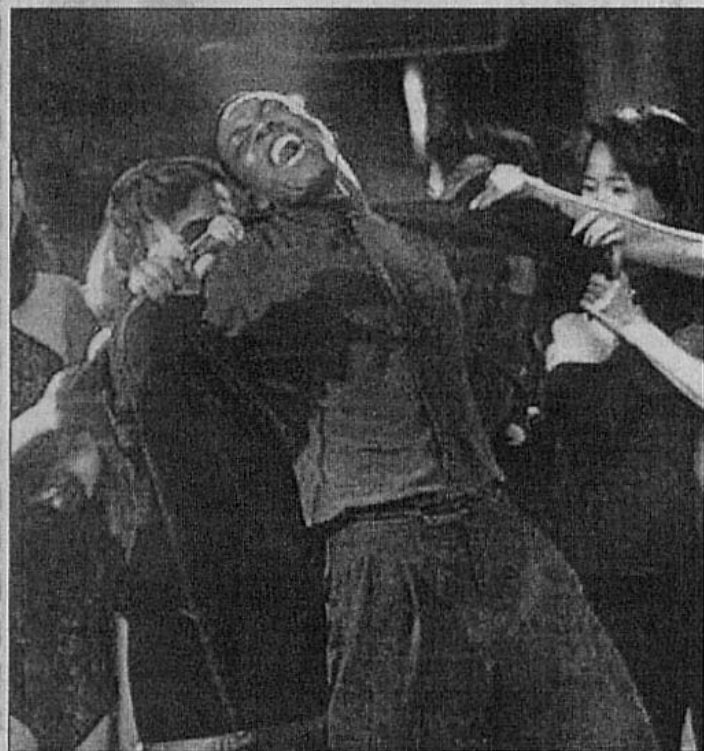

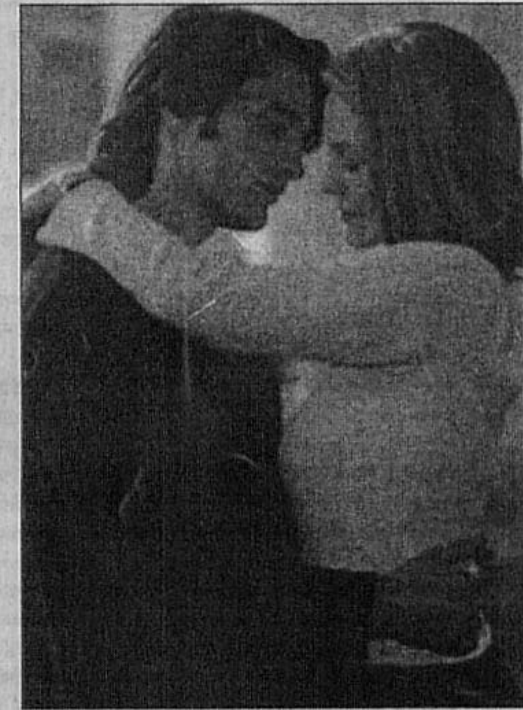


Antwone Fisher

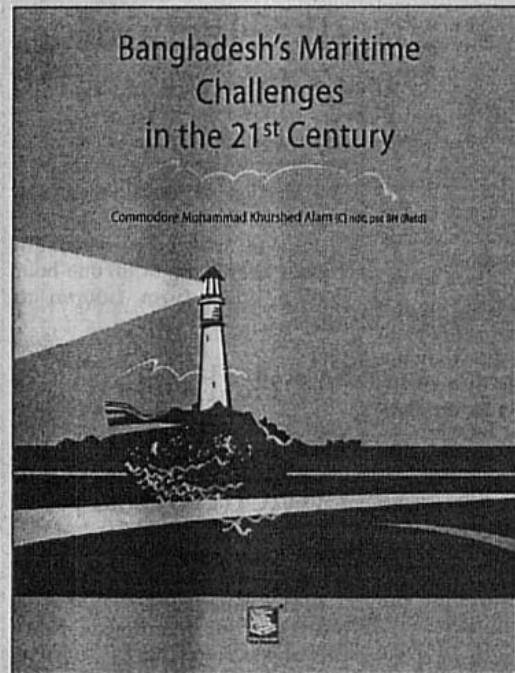


Gang Related (IMDb rating 5.7)

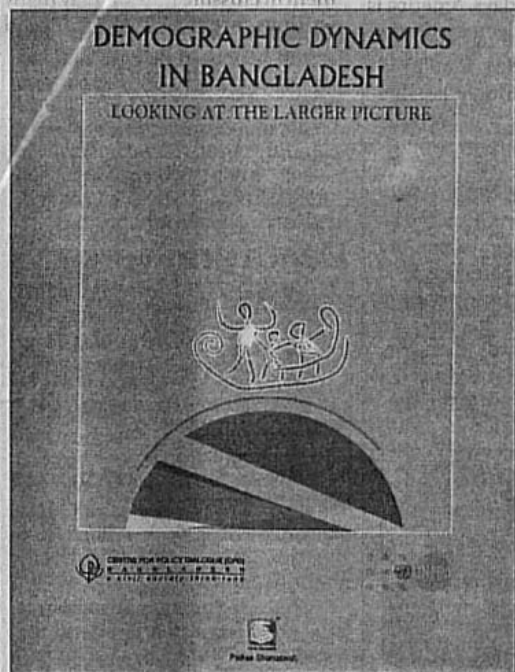


Unfaithful (IMDb rating 6.6)

The book focuses on the importance of the study about the Bay of Bengal covering various critical issues having implications for the country's maritime future. It highlights potential impact of the rivers/inland waterways in the transportation in maritime sector of internal and foreign trade, contribution of seaports and growth of shipping and related maritime administration. It also covers about the marine science, resources of the sea/beach, natural gas supply, the Law of the Sea, Bangladesh's maritime boundary and the issue of the South Talpatty, marine pollution, piracy, drug and arms trafficking, laws of armed conflict at sea, global climate change and natural disasters etc. Maritime resources discussed in the book can actually act as the Light House to re-direct the density of Bangladesh in the present century and beyond.

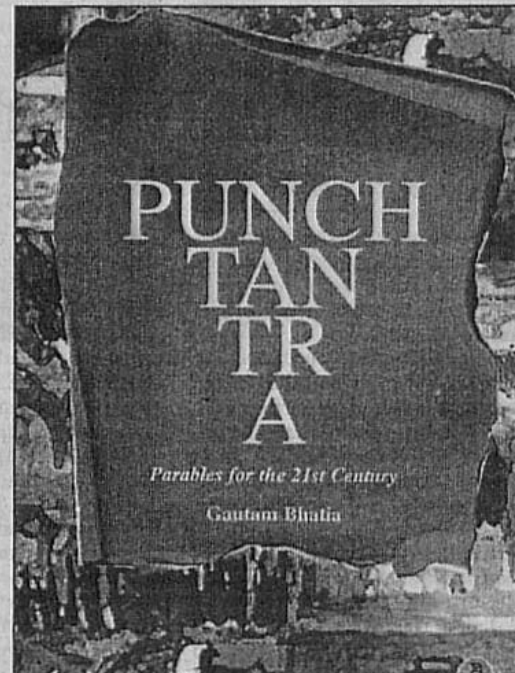


Demographic Dynamics in Bangladesh

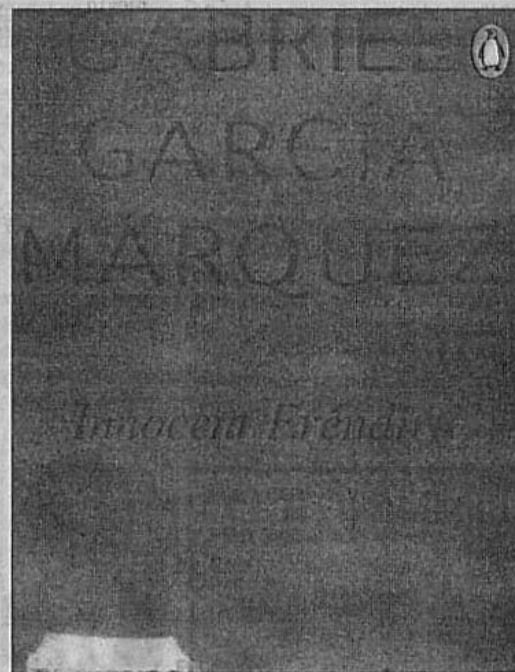


Selim Morshed Nirbachito Galpo

Importantly, the author has had to stand against the traditional diction of language for that purpose: nouns and adjectives change their regular places, words wear new meanings and verbs consciously fail to project the time of action in this new style of Selim's writing. Yet, the language of the 16 stories placed in this collection is ever so expressive. An activist of the little magazine throughout last two decades, Selim also expresses his stand against the institutionalisation of literature.

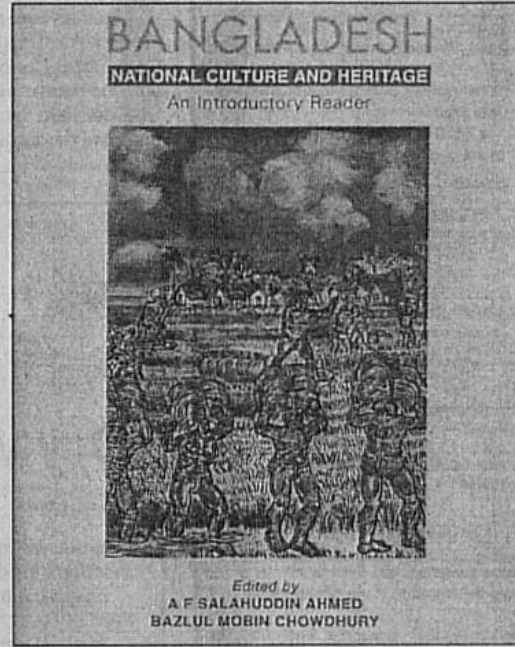

Inspired by James Finn Garner's *Politically Correct Bedtime Stories*, the author takes the men, women and animals of his book and relocates them in contemporary India with its newly acquired notions of political correctness. So we have the fiercely vocal lesbian feminist, Jaynadata, who leaves her husband for a woman; the expatriate dog Chitranga who flees racial persecution in the West; and a mongoose with an Oedipus complex, armed with a .45 Colt. As these characters engage with the burning issue of the day—unemployment, oppression, environmental pollution, sexual incontinuity—they lay bare the hilarious absurdities of our muddled world.



Innocent Eréndira

In his exotic and mystical style, García Márquez explores the themes of death, power, love and duty. Eréndira of the title story accidentally burns down her grandmother's house and is forced to pay her back with the money she earns from prostitution. But Eréndira thinks of a more appropriate way of repaying her. The themes initiated in this tale echo throughout this extraordinary book.

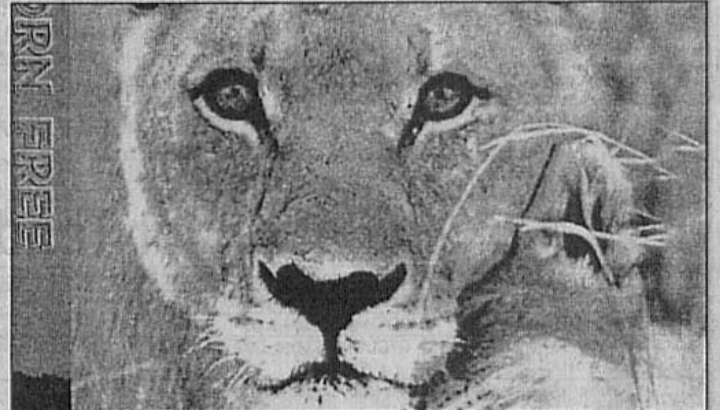


Brishtir Kanna

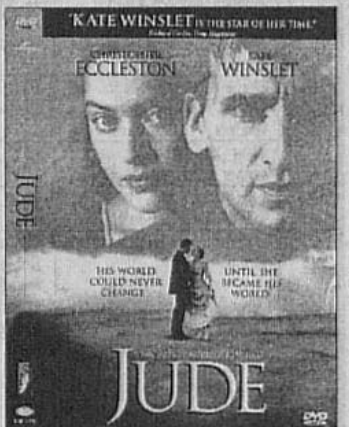
The Birds
