Gas field fire erupts at another point



4 die in 'crossfire'

Billal had recently been hiding in the capital with his associates, including Dilu, after unleashing a reign of terror in the district from which he hails, village Baniapara in the Kumarkhali upazila of Kushtia, said Rab officials.

Under interrogation by Rab, the outfit cadres admitted to their involvement with the underground party and to their possession of arms caches at various locations throughout Kushtia.

Rab-6 later left Dhaka to seize firearms from the village Swastipur in sadar upazila in Kushtia. They were ambushed by GMF cadres when they reached the village's Joynab Khatun non-government primary school at about 3:45pm, prompting them to retaliate. According to Rab, Billal and Dilu tried to jump from the Rab microbus during the hour-long gunfight and were caught in the crossfire. Both died on the spot.

After the shootout Rab retrieved one .22 rifle, one foreign rifle, one Kata rifle and 18 bullets from the spot.

Two Rab members were injured in the 'shootout', Rab sources said.

Police said Billal was accused in 18 criminal cases, including 7 murder cases filed with sadar and the Kumarkhali police. District police had also filed a number of allegations against Dilu regarding illegal procurement of government jobs. Police sent the bodies to Kushtia

An antismoking bill will be placed in the upcoming parliament session proposing a ban on all types of advertisements of tobacco products considered as a serious threat to publichealth.

The health ministry has submitted the much-talked about bill to the

Parliament Secretariat for enacting a law that will also ban smoking in public places.

The law will prohibit the publication of advertisements of tobacco products in newspapers, books and magazines and broadcast through radio, television and cinema.

Putting up billboards and printing leaflets and handbills or any other documents containing advertisement of tobacco will also be banned, the bill proposes.

No company will be allowed to distribute tobacco free of cost, arrange any competition and make any offer of scholarship or donation to make publicity of tobacco products.






