Rickshawpuller gets 32 yrs for throwing acid on wife

A Dhaka court Saturday sentenced a rickshawpuller to 32 years' rigorous imprisonment for throwing acid on his wife.

Judge Md Quamrul Hossain Mollah of Fifth Additional District and Sessions Judge's Court handed down the verdict on convict Md Chhahir Uddin alias

According to the prosecution, Kaltu threw acid on his wife Sufia Bibi on the night of January 22 last year when she was sleeping at their rented house at Nayagram slum in Kamrangirchar area, severely burning her throat, chest and hands.

The reason for the acid attack was that the rickshawpuller tried to engage his wife in immoral activities, but she refused to do so.

The victim's father Mohammad Nasir Uddin of Bogra filed a case with Kamrangirchar Police Station under the Acid Control Act on February 1. And the investigation officer pressed charges against Kaltu on April 3. Special Public Prosecutor Ilias




