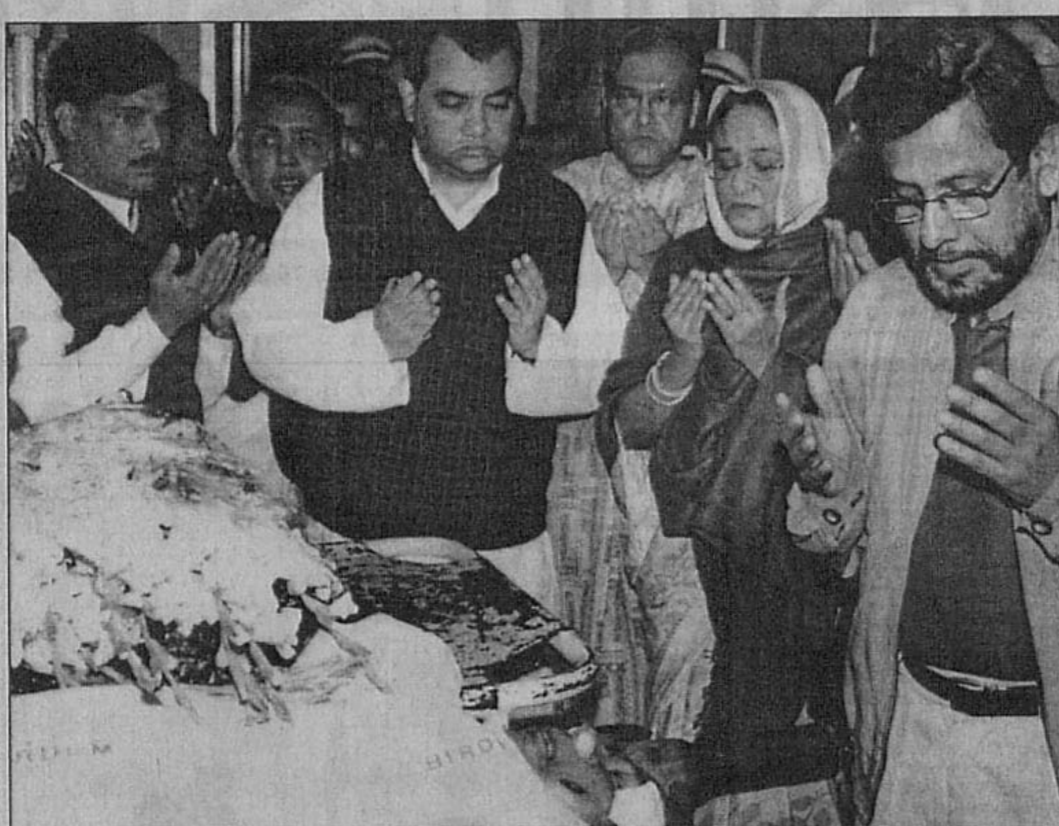

## Killing of Kibria, 4 others condemned

Different political parties held rallies and took out processions across the country yesterday to protest and condemn the killings of

former finance minister Shah AMS Kibria and four other Awami League activists at a grisly grenade attack at Boilder Bazar in Habiganj on Thursday.

Left-leaning 11 Party, Jatiya Samajtantrik Dal (JSD-Int) and six student organisations against terrorism and communalism also declared a three-day non-stop hartal protesting the killings.

JSD President Hasanul Haq Inu in a statement said Kibria was killed as part of the plan to make the progressive leadership vacant to establish communal, autocratic and family dynasty rule.

11 Party Co-ordinator Nurul Islam said if the killers were not held within next three days, they would go for tougher action programme.

Bangladesh Workers Party (WPB), Communist Party of Bangladesh (CPB) and 11 Party held a joint rally at Muktagong in the city to protest the grenade attack.

WPB President Rashed Khan Menon, CPB General Secretary Mujahidul Islam Selim and other leaders were present at the rally.

Later they brought out a procession that paraded different city streets.

Jahangirnagar University (JU) unit of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) yesterday barricaded the Dhaka-Aricha highway for fifteen minutes and took out a procession protesting the grenade attack.

The pro-AL teachers of JU also condemned the attack and demanded stern action against the criminals immediately.

AL and its front organisations in Chittagong held a rally and took out a procession in the city protesting the killing of Shah AMS Kibria and 4 others.

Police dispersed the procession and picked up five AL men from the spot.

Our staff correspondent from Chittagong adds: The presidium of Chittagong Chamber of Commerce and Industry (CCCI) has expressed deep shock at the killings of Kibria and others.

The presidium in a press statement said in the death of Kibria, the country had lost an internationally reputed personality who crowned the important posts of United Nations Under Secretary General and Escap Executive Secretary.

The signatories included CCCI President Saifuzzaman Chowdhury, Senior Vice-President SM Nurul Haq and Vice-president MA Latif. Bogra AL brought out a mourning procession from its district office and marched through the main streets.

AL leaders in Narayanganj at a rally protested the grenade attack. District AL Joint Convenor Mofizul Islam, Anisur Rahman Dipu, Sheikh Haider Ali, Advocate Khokon Saha spoke at the rally.

Mymensingh district AL leaders at a rally urged the people to make the three-day hartal a success.

The rally was addressed by district unit President Principal Motiur Rahman, and General Secretary Abdul Matin.

Earlier, a procession was brought out in the town.

Khulna AL leaders at a rally in the city demanded the resignation of Prime Minister Khaleda Zia for the failure of her government to ensure security of political leaders.

Local leaders of BNP, Jamaat, Jatiya Party, CPB and WPB also condemned the grenade attack and demanded immediate arrest of the criminals.

In Rajshahi, some 20 people were injured in clashes with police when AL leaders were protesting the Habiganj killings.

Of them, Rajshahi BCL President Abdul Momin, Abdul Khalil, Kaisar and Mainul were injured critically. The clashes erupted when police charged batons on a protest procession from the back at Sonadighi crossing.

AL and its front organisations in Barisal, Kusthia, Rangamati, Satkhira, Patuakhali, Manikganj and Nilphamari brought out processions and held rallies protesting the grenade attack in Habiganj.

And in Sylhet, police lobbed six tear gas shells and fired four gunshots in the town to disperse the agitators who were protesting the grenade attack in Habiganj.

They also charged baton on the protestors and arrested nine AL activists from Zindabazar area.

A protest rally was organised after the incident. It was addressed by City Mayor and City AL Chief Badar Uddin Ahmed Kamran, District AL President ANM Shafique, General Secretary Iftekhar Hossain Shamim, City AL General Secretary Misbah Uddin Siraj and ex-MP Shah Azizur Rahman.

## 6 killed in road accidents

Six people were killed in separate road accidents in Keraniganj and Comilla yesterday.

Of them, three people were killed when a Nawabganj-bound bus from Zinjira fell into a roadside ditch in Konakhola area of Keraniganj last night, according to UNB.

Fifteen others were also injured in the accident that took place at about 7:30pm as the driver lost control over the steering, police and local peoples said.

The injured were rushed to Dhaka Medical College Hospital. The condition of three was stated to be critical.

Our Comilla Correspondent adds: Three people were killed on Dhaka-Chittagong highway in Comilla.

Of them, two people were killed and 40 others injured when two Dhaka-bound buses collided in

Shatpara under Chouddagram upazila at around 1.00pm. The dead were identified as Jahangir Alam and his cousin Mohammad Hossain.

Protesting the incident, agitated people put up a barricade on the road, disrupting vehicular movement for about three hours.

Police seized the bus but the drivers managed to flee.

In another accident, a Chandpur-bound bus hit and split a trolley at Dharanipara under Chandina upazila at around 2.00pm, leaving a person dead and three others injured.

The dead was identified as Alamgir Hossain, son of Nuru Miah of village Charipara under Daudkandi upazila.

Police seized the bus but could not arrest the driver.

On Thursday night, 19 policemen were injured when a Dhaka-bound truck hit their vehicle at Kalachua in Burichong.

Of the injured, the condition of three was stated to be critical.

The truck sped away soon after the accident that took place at around 11.00pm.
