Police go too harsh on strikers

Opposition MPs, leaders assaulted; tempo driver killed; over 150 hurt on day two

The police were in a marauding mood yesterday, assaulting two opposition lawmakers and dozens of opposition leaders and activists as they staged demonstrations on the second day of the 60-hour coun-

trywide hartal. A tempo driver was killed and four others were injured as the three-wheeler turned turtle when the driver tried to escape an attack by hartal supporters in Ramganj of

Laxmipur district. Besides, more than 150 people were injured in the cop beating and sporadic clashes between the demonstrators and the police in Dhaka

and elsewhere. The pickets set

ablaze and damaged a number of vehicles, which were run defying the shutdown

SP, OC suspended to halt right probe?

The town bristles with a rumour that the government has suspended the chiefs of district and Sadar upazila police of Habiganj to prevent a fair investigation into Thursday's grenade carnage, not for their negligence in security measures, as is

Local Awami League leaders and a few well-placed sources claimed Superintendent of Police AMM Fakhrul Islam Khan and Sadar Police Station Officer-in-Charge Inam Ahmed Chowdhury suspended Saturday were on the scent of the perpetrators of the attack.

"Uncovering of the plot and identification of the people behind the outrage would have embarrassed the government, so, it has suspended the SP and the OC," said aknowledgeable source.

A certain clique of ruling coalition leaders and officials at the local administration might have had a hand in the suspension, he added.

Meanwhile second officer of the police station Afzalur Rahman has taken over the charge from Chowdhury. But, until yesterday evening, no-one replaced him as investigation officer of the two cases one for murder and the other


