

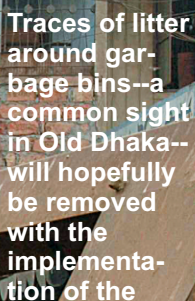

The intolerable traffic congestion of Dhaka has become an everyday plight for residents. The city has a very inadequate road network which constitutes only 8 -10 percent of the total city area whereas the acceptable ratio is 25 percent.
